


Venerable Anne de Guigné, born in Annecy-le-Vieux, Savoy, France, was the eldest of four children. Once a tyrannical toddler, her father's death in World War I at age 4 led her to change, becoming kind and obedient to comfort her grieving mother.

Anne made her First Communion at just 6 years old, which at the time still required a special dispensation because she was so young. Anne had a profound understanding of Jesus' presence in the Holy Sacrament. She developed a strong personal relationship with Jesus, whether in Mass, after Mass in prayer at the tabernacle, or at home, she declared that she loved to talk with "little Jesus." The grace of these prayerful conversations gave her a deep understanding of the reciprocal love between Jesus and his faithful.

When Anne was just 8 years old the first symptoms of the disease that would take her life appeared. But though her face was often disfigured from the pain, she offered her suffering as a sacrifice to God. She is attributed with saying, "we have many joys on earth, but they don't last; the one that lasts is to have made a sacrifice."

At just 10 years old, Anne died of meningitis. The cause for her sainthood was begun in 1932 and on March 3, 1990, she was declared venerable by Pope John Paul II.

A Message from Father

On the 27th Sunday in Ordinary Time, Deacon Tim talked about his experience of receiving the 7th sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. Before Vatican II, this sacrament was called Extreme Unction. It was largely reserved for those who were dying. Today, however, we see this sacrament as a sacrament of healing. Thus, it is no longer a sacrament reserved for the dying, but for anyone baptized who is

sick or preparing to undergo surgery.

Like the other sacrament of healing, which is Reconciliation, the presumption is that the recipient is of the age of reason. This relates to the gracious effect of the sacrament. While we certainly pray for physical healing, this sacrament especially offers healing to the soul afflicted by illness or injury. When we are sick or hurt, it is easy to turn inward and begin to practice self-loathing. The grace of the anointing of the sick heals the soul of the residual effects of sin and sanctifies the suffering of the recipient. When sick, we may think that God is punishing us. This sacrament offers healing to this mindset. Moreover, it sanctifies the suffering of the recipient. In other words, it unites the suffering of the recipient to that of Christ's suffering on the Cross. It empowers that suffering to be redemptive, not only for the sick person, but for those for whom the sick person offers their suffering.


The best time to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is when the person is conscious. This enables the person to intentionally unite their illness to Christ. Thus, the beginning of the illness or before surgery is the best time to receive the anointing. It is best not to wait until the person is nearly dead to offer the sacrament of the anointing of the sick. In a future article I will relate the anointing of the sick to the Last Rites.

Stewardship Reflection

Our Psalm today, "The Lord has done great things for us; we are filled with joy," sheds light on our glorious Gospel reading about the healing of the blind man, Bartimaeus.

We can learn a lot from Bartimaeus when it comes to our own personal relationships with Jesus. Many of us struggle with something from which we need healing — physical blindness, illness, addiction, bad habits, anger, sin. In our weakness, do we confidently cry out to Jesus knowing that He will help us?

Oftentimes we begin to, but then a voice in our thoughts tells us to doubt and encourages us to stop trying, like the crowd in our Gospel. Although that voice is persistent and strong, we are called to cry out all the more. If Jesus can hear one voice in a crowd of many, then He can hear our direct prayer to Him in our hearts.

Our Gospel story closes with the miraculous moment when Bartimaeus is healed. The conversation with Jesus was simple. Jesus asked Bartimaeus what he would like Him to do. This man, blind for who knows how many years, desired sight. Jesus responded, "Go your way; your faith has saved you." He was healed and continued to follow Christ.

There was not much that Bartimaeus had to do to become healed. All he needed was his undoubting faith.

Whatever it is that we are struggling with in this life, all Jesus asks of us is to have faith in Him. As a result, we will remain steadfast in our relationship with Christ and will have the strength to keep going. And although we might not be healed in this life, Jesus still hears our confident cries. And through our faith we will surely be healed in the next.


