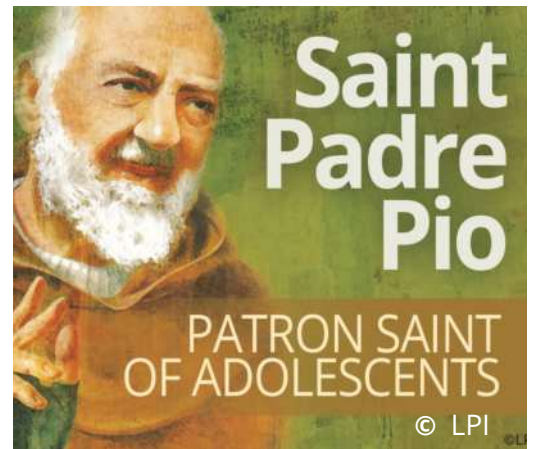

This saint, who is best known as Padre Pio, was born Francesco Forgione in 1887 in Pietrelcina, Italy. As a boy he suffered many illnesses, including typhoid. At 15, he joined the Capuchin Franciscans and took the name Pio, in honor of Pope Pius I. He was ordained in 1910, and at that time received the marks of the stigmata, the wounds of Christ, which eventually healed. Frequent illnesses continued to affect him as a young man.

Padre Pio served in the Italian Medical Corps during World War I but was discharged early due to illness, likely tuberculosis. He was then assigned to the friary in San Giovanni Rotondo. In 1918, the stigmata appeared again, remaining with him until his death.

His days were long, beginning with Mass at 5 AM, followed by hearing confessions and blessing the sick.

A simple man devoted to God's will, he saw Christ in the sick and poor and had the deep desire to serve. He urged the construction of a hospital, Casa Sollievo della Sofferenza (House for the Relief of Suffering), which opened in 1956.

Padre Pio died in 1968 at the age of 81. In 2002, Pope John Paul II canonized him St. Pio of Pietrelcina.

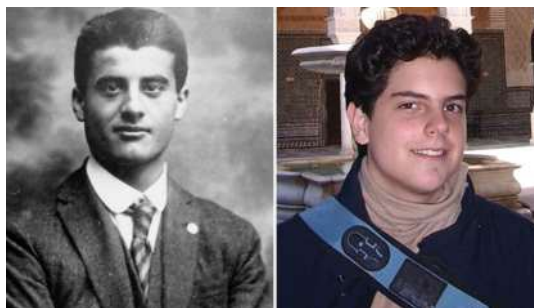

CELEBRATING TWO NEW SAINTS



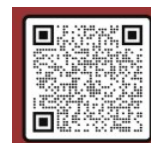

CATECHETICAL SUNDAY

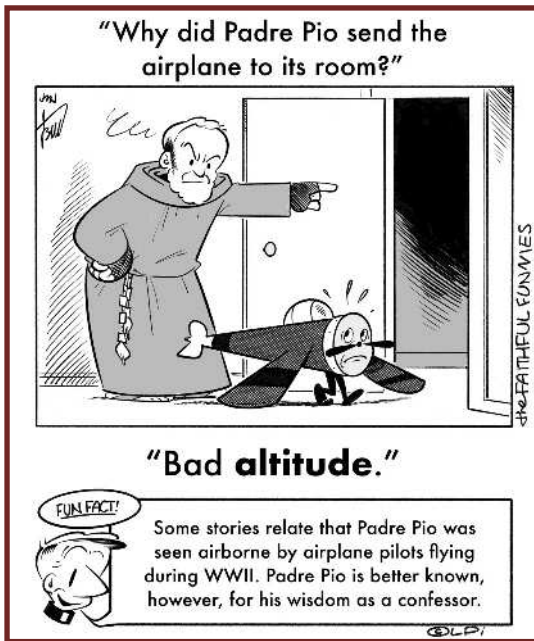

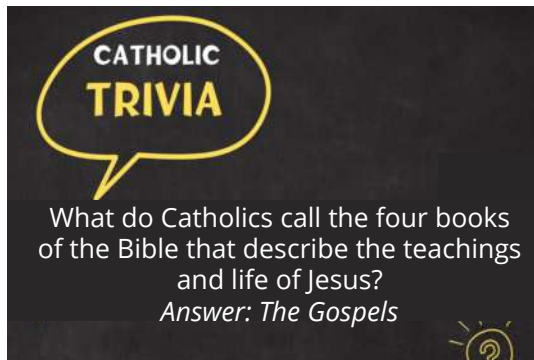
REFLECTIONS

The parable in today's the Gospel has a crooked steward who is commended by his master for being prudent, or clever, trying to protect himself. Jesus wanted us to be just as clever in serving the Lord. Let's look at the first two readings and how they challenge us to do more.

The reading from Amos talks about those *"who trample upon the needy and destroy the poor"* (Amos 8:4). The challenge here is to ask yourself, "What do I do for the poor?" Most parishes have organizations to help the needy and are happy to get volunteers. Do you ever think of praying for the poor?

Speaking of prayer, our second reading also challenges us to do more. Paul recommends prayers for *"kings and for all in authority"* (1 Timothy 2:2). It's easy to pray for friends and family; how much time do we give to prayers for government leaders and executives? Paul reminds us that God wants everyone to be saved (1 Timothy 2:4), sinners as well as saints, terrorists and embezzlers, atheists and agnostics. I'll bet you don't spend much time praying for the "bad guys." Yet Jesus said, *"Love your enemies. Pray for those who hurt you"* (Matthew 5:44). I can't say I've ever heard anyone say that was their favorite Bible passage. But if Jesus expects more from those who love him, who are we to let him down?

Why do Catholics eat fish on Friday?

For centuries, Catholics abstained from meat on Fridays to honor the day Jesus died, offering prayer, penance, and self-denial. This practice became Church teaching until the Second Vatican Council in the 1960s, when cultural and economic differences led to a broader understanding: in some places, avoiding meat was no sacrifice, while in others, seafood was a luxury.

Today, Catholics worldwide still abstain from meat on Lenten Fridays. In some countries, like England and Wales, this is done every Friday. U.S. bishops invite Catholics to either abstain from meat or perform another act of penance or charity each Friday.

Whatever form it takes, the goal is the same: to see each Friday as a reminder of Good Friday and to honor Jesus' self-giving love through sacrifice or mercy.

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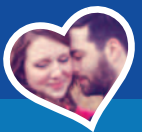


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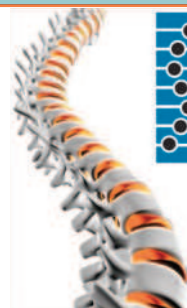
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
