

Clergy Corner

Shortly before Christmas, I became ill with the "super flu" - the influenza A variant that is circulating this season. The illness was significant and required a full week of recovery, which meant I was unable to celebrate Mass publicly for Christmas. Because of the severity of this variant, I made the decision to stop the distribution of the Precious Blood during the flu season. I realize this may be a disappointment for some, but this decision is made out of care - to protect not only the congregation, but myself, from illness.

Since developing psoriatic arthritis in my first year at Saint Alphonsus Liguori, I have been on an immunosuppressant that immensely helps alleviate my arthritis but also leaves me more susceptible to illness. Taking reasonable precautions helps ensure that I stay as healthy as possible and remain present and available to serve our parish. This is especially holds true

while Fr. Matthew is away visiting family in Nigeria for the next month.

It is important to remember that Jesus is fully present - Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity - under both forms of the Eucharist. Whenever we receive either the Precious Blood or the Body of Christ, we receive all of Christ.

For those with gluten intolerance or celiac disease, low-gluten hosts remain available. Sometimes the gluten allergy is too great to use a low gluten host. If this is true, we can make an exception by having a chalice to specifically meet these needs, so that no one is excluded from receiving Our Lord.

Thank you for your understanding, your prayers, and your continued care for one another as members of the Body of Christ.



Born in Northern Italy, orphaned in childhood, Angela Merici faced a society in which education was largely the privilege of wealthy young men and based primarily in monastic schools. This reality shaped Angela's insightful conviction that society's disorder was caused by disorder in the home, and a lack of model Christian mothers the result of neglecting the education of young women.

Transform the Christian family by placing an educated wife and mother at its heart, Angela believed, and the whole world would be renewed in Christ! So she gathered a small group of unmarried women, many of them Franciscan Tertiaries (lay affiliates) like herself, and set out to educate poor girls, free of charge, in their homes. She and her band of teachers called themselves "companions," pioneering a new form of non-cloistered religious life for women, bearing witness to evangelical simplicity in the midst of the world, not as a formal "order" but as the "Company (compagnia) of Saint Ursula."

Known today as the Ursulines, Angela Merici's spiritual daughters continue serving the Church and society in a rich diversity of ministries.




Our Prayer Ministry Team offers compassion and peace through prayer. This is not a sacrament or priestly blessing but a uniting of Christians in prayer.

Stewardship Reflection

Today's readings remind us that stewardship is not just a thing we do — rather, stewardship is at the core of who we are as disciples of Christ.



Our first reading, from Isaiah, contains this prophecy of Christ and what His saving message would mean to all who embrace it. "The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light; upon those who dwelt in the land of gloom a light has shone." We are among those blessed people on whom the light of Christ has shone. By virtue of our Baptism, we, who were once in the darkness of original sin, have been reborn into the great light that is God's grace in us. We are cherished members of God's family.

What a privilege! Yet, with this privilege comes the responsibility to actually live for God and to bring His Good News to all those we meet — at work, at school, in our community and right in our own home — in other words, to live as His good stewards.

And there is a certain urgency that comes with the call to a stewardship way of life as we see in our Gospel passage from Matthew. Jesus says, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand." In other words, turn away from selfishness, turn towards God and live as His disciple now — don't wait!

In this same passage, the very first disciples give us examples of a good steward's prompt "yes" when the Lord called to them. Our Lord invites them to "Come after me and I will make you fishers of men." They did not hesitate but "at once they left their nets and followed him." They put our Lord and His will first.

This is the essence of a stewardship way of life — to be always ready for the ways that our Lord is calling us to bring His light to others. It's more than something we do — it's who we are.



St. Alphonsus Liguori Parish has a part-time Baptism Coordinator position available - up to 10 hours per week with some duties able to be completed remotely.


