



## Clergy Corner

### *How Did I Get Here?*

In 2008, I interviewed for a job that included leadership responsibilities. I believe the Holy Spirit was alive and well during that interview, which involved the president of the company and the director of human resources. I had several things I wanted to say in that interview and was able to speak to each of them, including most importantly how I so frequently wind up in leadership positions. I told them I don't know how or why this happens, but there have been many instances where people who knew me nominated or recommended me for positions that I wasn't necessarily scheming to achieve.

During formation for the diaconate a few years later, we went through Called and Gifted, a process to understand what our spiritual gifts, or charisms, might be and to try to understand what those charisms mean. There are 21 charisms, and it turns out that one of my top charisms is service. One description of those who have the charism of service is that they see the need for something to happen and then actually step in and make it happen. For example, I had earlier attended a

gathering where many people brought food to share, but no one was eating it. I thought that was a shame, so I picked up trays of food and walked around the room offering it to the participants.

In Called and Gifted, I learned that others see this tendency to jump in, which is the charism of service, and mistake it as leadership! Eureka! That explained so much and unraveled a mystery that had puzzled me for years.

This is one story of how impactful and helpful it is to understand our charisms and how we can best use them. It's also very helpful to understand what our gifts are not and to relieve ourselves of any guilt we feel when we struggle at a task or activity that is not our spiritual gift. This is truly liberating.

We will not be disappointed, but rather enlightened and affirmed, if we participate in Called and Gifted, starting this coming Wednesday. In fact, it may indeed explain how we got where we are today and where the gifts God gave us can lead us in His service in the future.

## St. Scholastica (c. 480 - 543)

*Feast Day: February 10*

What we know about Saint Scholastica is credited to the writings of her twin brother Benedict, who was a great reformer of monastic life and founder of the convent of Monte Cassino.

Following the example of her brother, Scholastica founded a monastery for women in Plombariola. Since entry to people of the opposite sex was prohibited in both communities, Benedict and Scholastica met once a year at an intermediate point to pray and talk about spiritual life.

According to sources, when it was time to say goodbye during their last meeting, Scholastica insisted that Benedict stay rather than return to the convent, but he refused. Then, Scholastica implored God for her brother to remain and the response was a copious storm, such that leaving was unthinkable. Benedict recognized in this action not only the will of God, but also the request that his sister had made to the same God they loved so much. Three days later, Scholastica was called to the eternal homeland.

Scholastica valued small things and trust in God.
