

### *Catholic Ministries Appeal: Called to Serve*

## The Seven Holy Founders of The Order of The Servants of Mary

*Feast Day: February 17*

The Seven Holy Founders of the Order of the Servants of Mary (Servites) were a group of laymen from Florence, Italy, who lived in the 13th century. United by deep friendship and a shared devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary, they felt called to leave their prosperous lives as merchants and civic leaders to pursue prayer and penance.

In 1233, amid social unrest and spiritual decline in their city, they withdrew to Mount Senario, where they embraced a life of simplicity, community, and service. Wearing black as a sign of mourning for the sufferings of Christ and His Mother, they cultivated a spirituality of compassion, marked especially by meditation on the *Seven Sorrows of Mary*.

From this humble beginning, the Order of the Servants of Mary was born, dedicated to preaching, pastoral care, and fostering devotion to Our Lady.

Canonized together, the Seven Holy Founders are remembered for their radical response to God's call, their love for Mary, and their enduring witness to fraternal charity and humble service.

In solidarity we pray for our mothers and fathers. May they always have the wisdom to guide us and the perseverance to create a home of unconditional acceptance.



Guiding Principals

**Connectivity:** Create campus connectivity to encourage parish interaction and meaningful fellowship outside of Mass and improve synergy between activities and spaces.

**Interaction:** Provide multi-purpose [spaces] that support various ministries, meetings, and impromptu intergenerational social interactions throughout campus and foster community outreach.

**Capacity:** ... more parking, more Mass seating, a rectory that supports multiple priests, more classroom and religious education spaces...

**Welcome:** Enhance the accessibility, wayfinding, and visibility of the parish to allow ease of access and create a welcoming environment for people of all ability levels...

**Enhanced Worship Space:** Address acoustical and A/V challenges; address space needs for children; study updating the sanctuary...and allow more seating for Mass attendance.

**Stewardship:** Good financial stewardship of the parish's available financial resources will guide decisions about the implementation of the Master Plan.





Since 2017, through strategic mergers and territory expansion, the Indianapolis-based organization has grown its reach to serve individuals across central and southern Indiana, central Illinois, and the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico. In 2025, Goodwill of Central Indiana further expanded its impact through a merger with Horizon House, a leading Indianapolis-based homelessness service provider.

Kramer was elected to the Goodwill Industries International Board of Directors in 2019 and was appointed by Governor Eric Holcomb to serve on the Indiana Commission for Higher Education.






