




Clergy Corner

The Church has always thought that “peace is not the absence of war, but rather the presence of justice and love.” When we are confronted with any kind of ruptured ties—family, community or group—we must seek peace and reconciliation by emphasizing what *unites* rather than what divides. Think of our “common

humanity” (Gen.1:26-27) and cultivate the ability to listen to the other person to understand their “locus standi.”

Above all, deal with others as *humans* with personality and dignity, not as *things*. Whatever caused the rupture does not make others less human. Ruptured ties can breed anger and pain, leading to building walls and burning bridges. It can also shut doors of discussion or conversation or lead to silent treatment. We must always realize that dialogue helps to repair damaged relationships. Let us pray with Eusebius:

*May I be no person’s enemy. May I be a friend of that which is eternal and abides. May I never quarrel with those nearest to me, and if I do, may I be reconciled quickly. May I love, seek and attain only that which is good. May I*

*wish all people happiness and envy none. May I never rejoice in the ill fortune of one who has wronged me. When I have done or said what is wrong, may I never wait for rebuke of others, but always rebuke myself until I amend. May I win no victory that harms either me or my opponent. May I reconcile friends who are angry with one another. May I never fail a friend who is in danger. When visiting those in grief, may I be able, by gentle and healing words, to soften their pain. May I respect myself and always keep tame that which rages within me. May I become accustomed to being gentle and never be angry with people because of circumstances. May I never discuss who is wicked and what wicked things the person has done but know good people and follow their footsteps.*

St. Joseph

FEAST DAY: MARCH 19

Joseph is the only major character in Jesus’ story who never utters a word. But the Gospel recounts and the liturgy celebrates his silent witness of faith-filled deeds.

Catholic devotion, therefore, hails him as patron-protector of the universal Church. Some cultures set a festive “Saint Joseph’s Table,” welcoming the poor and strangers to feast with family and friends. Tradition keeps March 19 as the anniversary of his death, which we presume was peaceful and with Jesus and Mary present. Thus,

Catholics invoke Joseph as “patron of a happy death.” Descended from David’s house, which God finished “building” through Joseph’s provision of a home for Mary and Jesus, he was, fittingly, a carpenter by trade and, thus, the patron of workers. Spring, nature’s rebirth, begins between his feast and The Annunciation (March 25), appropriately, since Joseph’s silent obedience and Mary’s “Let it be done to me according to your word” (Luke 1:38) usher in humanity’s spiritual rebirth.



**Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion REFRESHER MARCH 21-22**

All Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are required to attend a brief, 15-minute refresher session. The last opportunity is after Mass, **March 21-22**. Sessions include prayer, a review of the components of the role and time for questions.

**Did You Know? Indulgences**

Indulgences are an opportunity from the Church to draw on the merits of Jesus, Mary and the saints. Indulgences can be **full (plenary)** or **partial** and help to remit the temporal punishment due to sin that has been forgiven—for yourself or a deceased person.

To receive a full indulgence, one must be in a state of grace, as well as participate in an indulgenced activity, receive the Eucharist, pray for the Pope and attend confession within several weeks of the activity. Participating in the Stations of the Cross offers a full indulgence, as do many other activities like:

- ½ hour of adoration
- ½ hour of reading Scripture
- Reciting 5 decades of the Rosary in community & in a Church
- Participating in Adoration of the Cross on Good Friday


Wondering what Eucharistic Adoration is all about? Or what exactly you need to do when you come to spend time with Jesus?
