
I was recently at one of the many funerals we have had lately and was surprised to see various people I knew from previous chapters of my life, not knowing they were acquainted with the deceased. And, again, at one of our Fish Fries, there were friends of mine from earlier times, who spoke of being related to our parishioners and how much they loved this relation of theirs. I had no idea of these connections and this fondness, and it's always so interesting and exciting to learn of them.

We all hear today how Martha knew Jesus in His ultimate reality, the Christ, the Son of God. Her faith and understanding can be a surprise if we think about Martha's earlier complaining about her sister Mary "wasting time"

with Jesus, sitting at his feet and listening while Martha scurried about as a devoted hostess. Yet Martha is one of the first in the Gospels to proclaim Jesus as the Son of God. She really knew Him, even though she appeared not to "get it" earlier.

There are several lessons for me here. One, you never know when people will finally "get it" and understand who Jesus really is. There's always hope. Secondly, we can never tell who or what are in people's backgrounds that may be a springboard for new relationships and the basis for honoring the life and the goodness of others. Thirdly, at funerals, you can make wonderful connections, even if under the unfortunate circumstances of the death of a loved one. Make sure you take time to plan your own funeral.

Getting to know others and getting to know Jesus are never a waste of time. May our Lenten journeys continue to help us connect with others and especially with Jesus.

Easter Mass Parking Details



Because Easter Masses are some of the busiest of the year, here are some helpful hints for parking at these Masses:

- Please arrive early and be patient. Parking will be difficult due to our parish's growth.
- Overflow Handicap Parking: Sixteen additional spaces will be available in the parking lot adjacent to the All Souls Center, which is southwest of the main entrance to the church.
- Fire Lanes: **No parking** directly behind the northside of the church in the fire lanes. **THIS IS A SAFETY CONCERN** in the event of a fire.
- Sports Field Parking Lot: If you park here, please use caution crossing the street before and after Mass.
- Primary overflow regular parking will be in the Medical Building Parking Lot to the east of the church grounds. Please use the sidewalk on Oak Street to walk to the church.
- Additional overflow parking, weather permitting, will be the **Grass Lot** north of the church. Please follow directions from parking volunteers.






