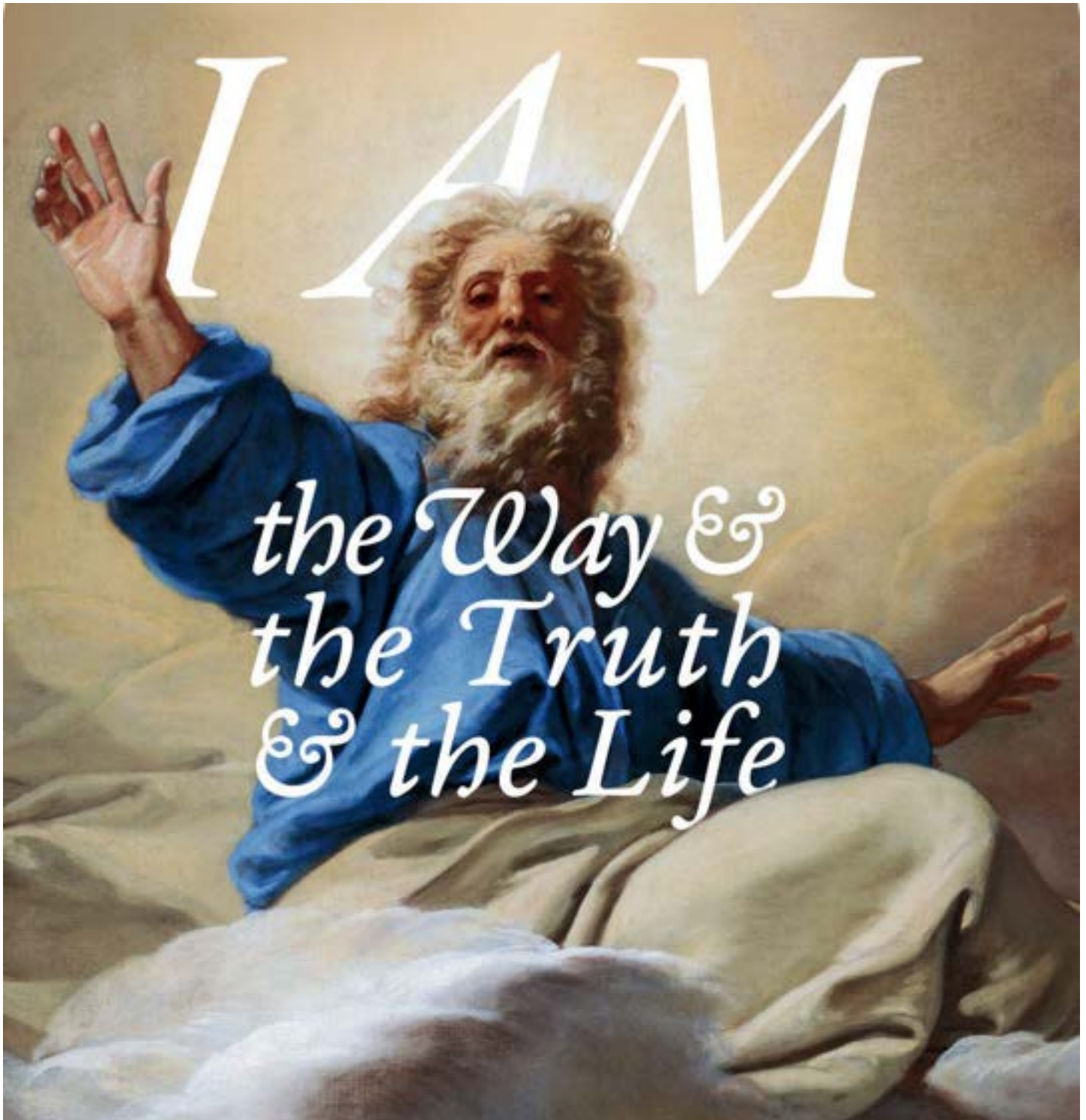

Saints Philip & James, Apostles

FEAST DAY: MAY 3

Philip, the apostle, was asked many questions. “Can anything good come out of Nazareth?” Nathaniel asked Philip (Jn 1:45). Jesus asked Philip, “Where can we buy enough food for them to eat?” (Jn 6:5). Greeks brought Philip their request: “We would like to see Jesus” (Jn 12:21). Philip’s answer to each question: **bring people to Jesus!**

Jesus had three last questions for Philip: “You still don’t know me? How can you ask that? Don’t you believe?” And an answer: “I am in the Father and the Father is in me” (Jn 14:10).

At the Last Supper, Philip had his own request “Show us the Father!” (Jn 14:8).

Today’s James is not John’s brother, Zebedee’s son, but the author of the New Testament Letter of James, tradition says. He died praying for his murderers in Jesus’ words: “Forgive them, for they know not what they do.”

There are few historical details for either saint, but we can learn to bring every question we have and everybody we meet to Jesus; be, as James’ letter challenges, “doers of the word and not hearers only” (Jas 1:22).

Clergy Corner

Welcome to the month of May! Fr. Matthew’s birthday kicks off the month on May 1. We have the Indy 500 coming up, and the Mini Marathon was this past Saturday. Most notably, however, **the month of May is dedicated to Mary in the Catholic Church.**

Who is Mary to us, to you and to me individually, and who was she to Jesus? The Gospels tell us Jesus was obedient to Mary and to Joseph, and He performs His **first miracle** because of her prompting. So, there’s that!

I have a good friend who suggested that before our feet hit the floor in the morning, we should first hit our knees, and I choose to do so while praying the **Memorare** that we all pray at the end of Mass. This past Friday May 1, along with other pilgrims, I was at the **Marian Apparition site of Knock, Ireland**, where Mary appeared along with Sts. Joseph, John the Apostle and Jesus Himself in the form of a lamb. And speaking of Marian Apparitions, Fr. Travis and I are planning a pilgrimage to Lourdes, France, and Madrid and Barcelona, Spain, in October 2027. More to come!

A mystic in Bolivia, Catalina Rivas has seen visions of many things during Mass, such as angels rising from everyone at Mass at the Offertory, some carrying vessels containing what their person was praying for, some carrying nothing because their person wasn’t offering anything. This has prompted me to make sure I am always offering something at every Mass, praying for some person in need.

Regarding Mary, Catalina has seen **Jesus** standing in the place of the priest during the consecration with Mary behind him. During the consecration, I am kneeling slightly behind the priest, and I sometimes imagine Mary next to me. You may have seen me slightly lean into Mary during the consecration.

Along with learning about the establishment of the diaconate in the **Book of Acts** this weekend, we hear in our Gospel how Jesus shows us the way to the Father. Mary shows us the way to Jesus. We would do well to lean into her a little more.

Regarding the Indy 500, I will be rooting for the driver who is packing a rosary during the race!
