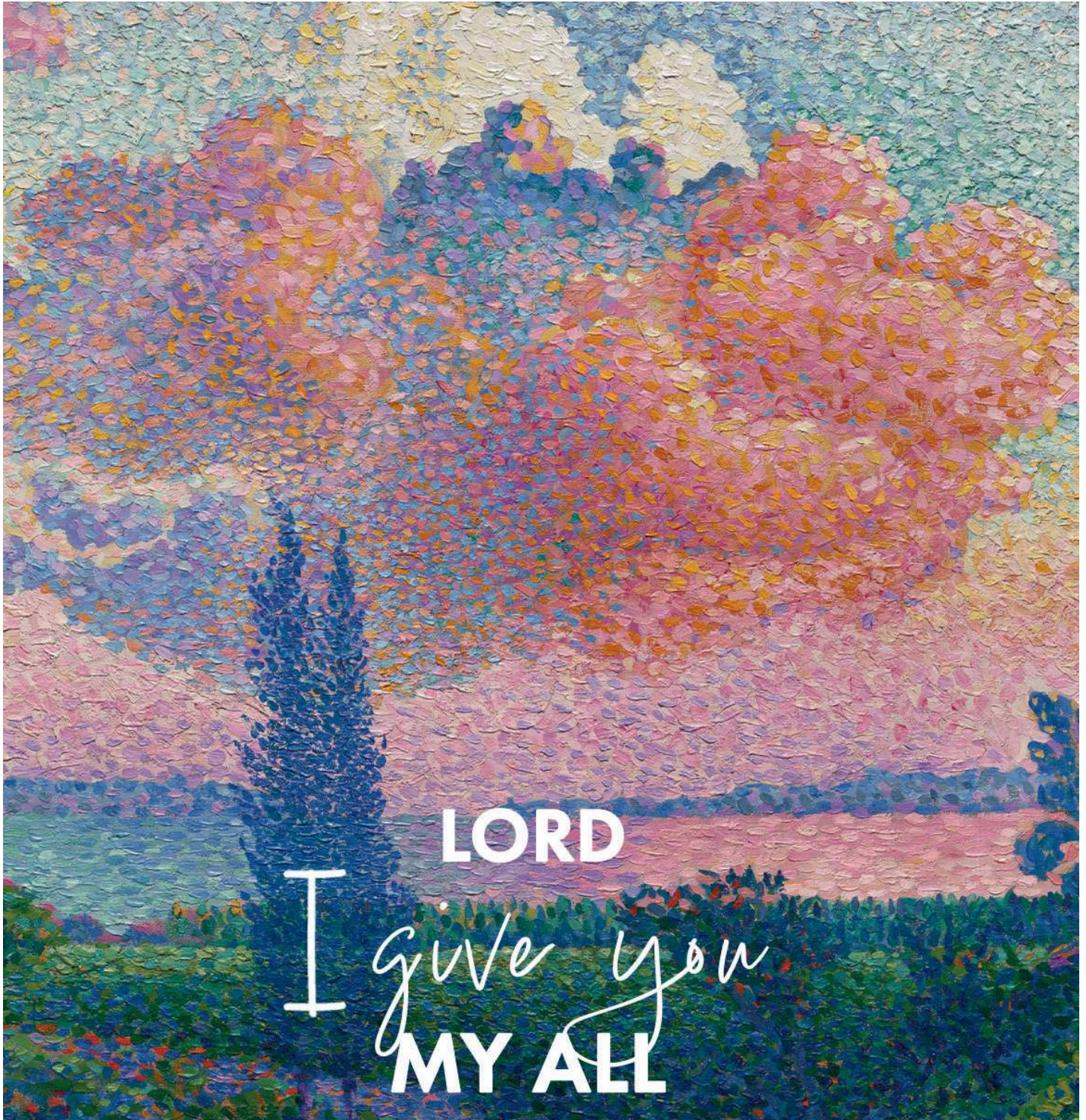

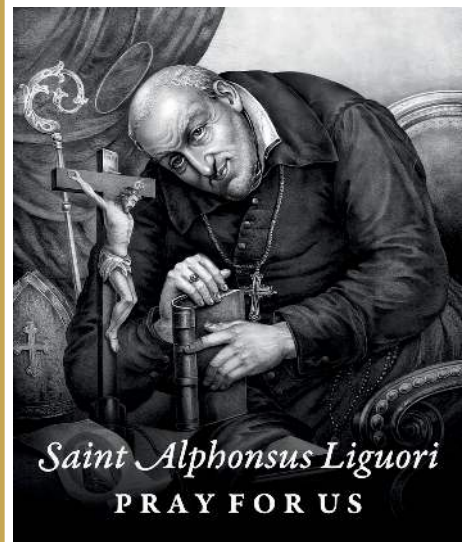

St. Alphonsus Liguori FEAST DAY: AUGUST 1 1696-1787

St. Alphonsus Liguori, our parish's patron saint, was born near Naples, Italy, into a noble family.

He spent his young adult years as an accomplished attorney, though in his late 20s, he heard a voice telling him to **"Leave the world and give thyself to Me."** Despite the hopes of his family that he would marry, he was ordained a priest, eventually becoming the bishop to a small diocese near Naples. He would also go on to found his own order: the **Redemptorist Congregation.**

St. Alphonsus suffered from many ailments throughout his life, including an illness that left his head bent at the neck, making it both painful and difficult to consume liquid except through a tube.

He wrote many books, healed the sick, experienced ecstasies, foretold the future and is said to have **appeared in spirit** to the dying Pope Clement XIV. St. Alphonsus Liguori is a **Doctor of the Church** and patron of those with arthritis.

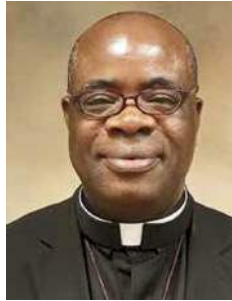

Clergy Corner: The Divine Quest

Therefore, Christianity correctly understood is the questing and self-emptying of Divine Love (Phil 2:6-11). This divine action enables Christians to become friends of God and sharers in the communion of the Trinity. ***This is the essence of Christianity:*** God sent His Son into the dysfunction of our world, so that He might gather that world into the bliss of the divine life.

As a result of the love between the Father and the Son, *God's center* is now offered to us as *our center*. **Through Christ, God's heart breaks open to include even the worst and most hopeless among us.** This implies that God makes us His children through forgiveness despite all of our unworthiness. He wakes us up each morning even in the middle of our dreams for a new beginning, because of His continuous breath into us.

Contrary to founders of certain religions who have told their followers they have found the truth, Jesus goes further and tells us that HE is **"the Way, the Truth and the Life."** It is in Him that we see the glory of God. God is not made of materials things. *He cannot come out of hiding because He is not hiding from us.* He is all around us, but we can only know Him through a faith that fills our minds and hearts, and Jesus has pointed out that way of faith to us.

Our relic is **ex ossibus** (from the bone) of St. Alphonsus. It was a gift from the Provincial House of Redemptorists in Denver, Colorado.

Our previous pastor, Father Dennis O'Keeffe, took a pilgrimage to that Redemptorist House in 2007. Thus began a relationship and conversation with the Denver Province, to which our parish belongs. Several years later, they sent us this **1st class relic of St. Alphonsus Maria de Liguori**.

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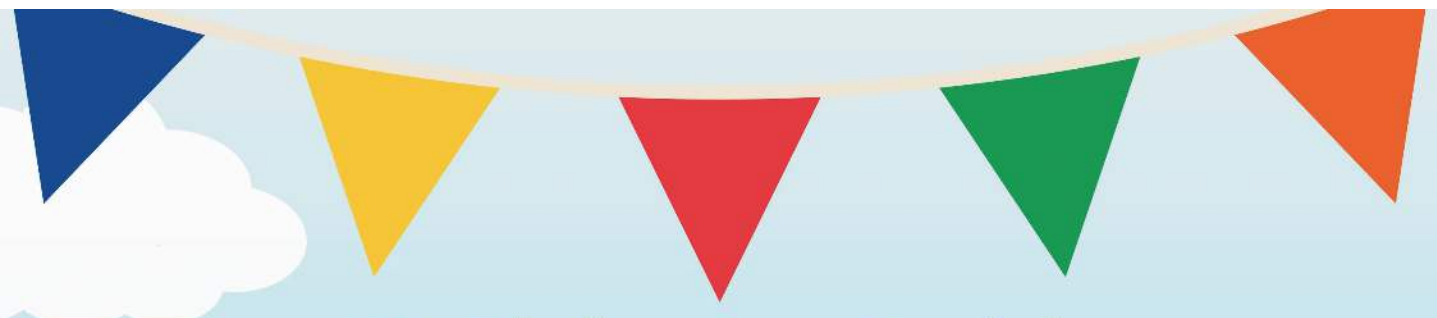

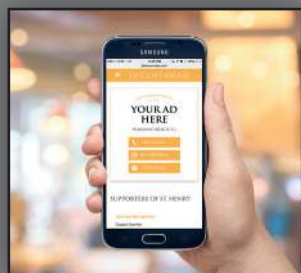
Marriage
