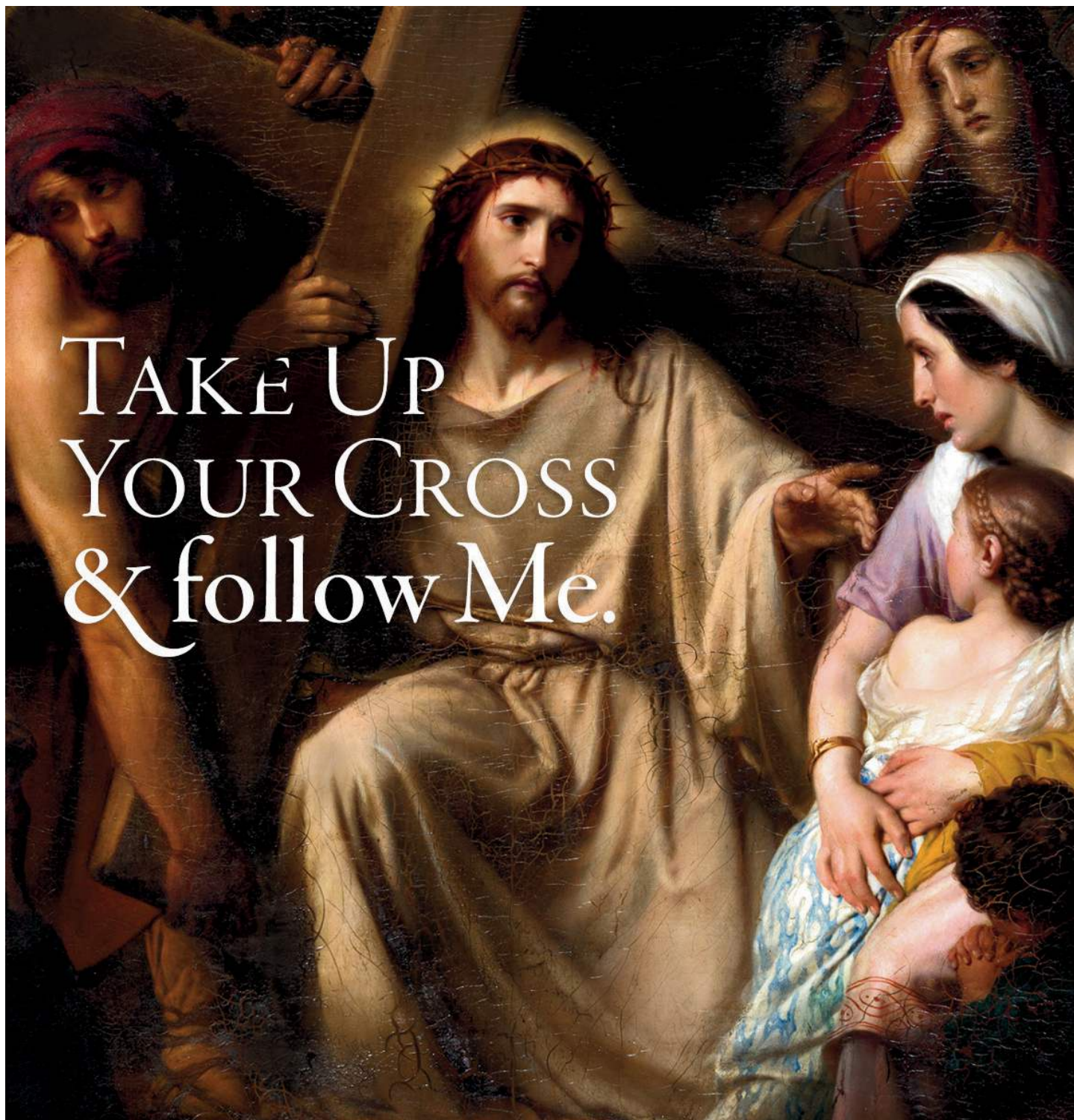

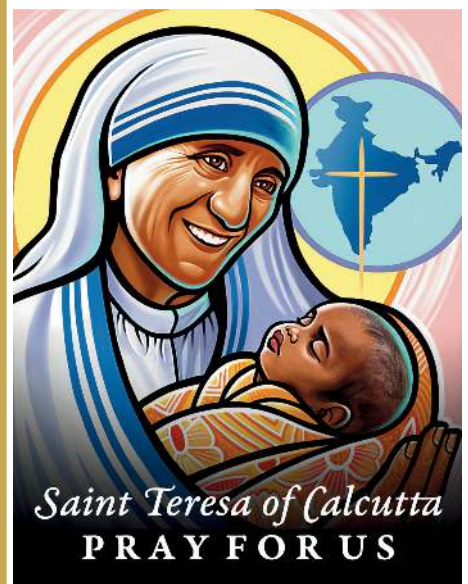

St. Mother Teresa of Calcutta

FEAST DAY: SEPTEMBER 5

Mother Teresa was born in the city of Skopje in the Balkans in 1910 and named Gonxha Agnes. Her father died when she was only 8, and at 18, she joined the Institute of the Blessed Virgin Mary, or, the Sisters of Loreto, in Ireland. There, she received the name Sister Mary Teresa after St. Thérèse of Lisieux.

She was sent to Calcutta, India, where she taught at a school for girls. On September 10, 1946 during a train ride from Calcutta to Darjeeling, she received an "inspiration." She said Jesus' thirst for love and for souls took hold of her heart and the desire to satiate His thirst became the driving force of her life. He asked her to establish a religious community, the Missionaries of Charity, dedicated to the service of the poorest of the poor.

She famously experienced a "darkness" of being separated from God, which nevertheless led her to an ever more profound union with Him. Mother Teresa received many awards for her work, including the Nobel Peace Prize in 1979. She died in 1997 and was canonized in 2002.

Editor's Corner: Emptying Ourselves to Be Filled With God

In this weekend's Gospel, Jesus says, "Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross and follow me. For whoever wishes to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake will find it."



What does it mean to "deny yourself," "take up your cross" and "lose your life"? I define it as a concept we see many of the saints illustrate: *emptying yourself* so as to **be filled with God**. The fancy Greek word for this is *kenosis*.

The prime example of this is Jesus himself. St. Paul says that Christ, "though he was in the form of God, did not regard equality with God something to be grasped...he emptied himself, taking the form of a slave" (Phil 2:7). Jesus is the master pattern on which we all are to model ourselves. But, of course, Jesus was God. How do we achieve this as humans? **Let's look to Mary.** Mary, too, emptied herself, giving her full assent to be the Mother of God when she says, "may it be done to me according to your word" (Luke 1:38).

Why do we need to empty ourselves? Because we are full of fallen tendencies to sin. We need to let go of pride, control, over-attachment to the material, busyness and so much more.

When we do this, we can fill ourselves with God as much as possible. God desires to make us like Himself, to "divinize" us even, and that cannot happen without making room for Him. We have a hint of Mary's divine fullness when the Angel Gabriel calls her "**full of grace.**" When you are "full", there is no room for anything else. That is when God can truly work miracles in our lives as He did hers, allowing us to produce much fruit.

"It is only by making ourselves little that we become great; it is only by creating an emptiness that Heaven has a place to fill," said Archbishop Fulton Sheen

But remember the story from Matthew 12:43-45 about a person who cleaned out their soul, expelling an "unclean spirit," only to find seven more taking its place.

The point is that when you empty yourself, you must fill yourself with God. Stay close to the sacraments, **especially the Eucharist**. At Mass, I pray for the Holy Spirit to fill my soul full to overflowing, that He would be like a rushing river overflowing from me, touching all the souls I encounter each day. Amen.

When We Change Through Prayer, Parishes Change: Help Us Realize Our Goal of 24/7 Adoration

Think back to August 2020... We were in the midst of a pandemic, and Mass attendance was 550 people each week. Before Covid, we averaged 1170 people per week. We had just one priest. There was talk of stopping the 5pm Mass. This was the state of our parish when Father arrived on a summer day, August 19, 2020.

Despite this being his first assignment as pastor, Father did not let the obstacles faze him; he had a vision. And that vision was to make a **perpetual adoration chapel** where people could pray with Jesus at any hour of the day, seven days a week.

Why? Because *prayer changes us*, but most especially, *it changes people* when they spend time in the presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. **When we change through prayer, parishes change.**



Six years later, we have:

- 2,200 people attending Mass each week
- 125 regular adorers
- Our largest ever Becoming Catholic/OCIA class

Father's Vision is about to come to completion as we launch our perpetual adoration campaign! The goal of the campaign is to fill our chapel hours by the week of November 29, the first week of Advent.

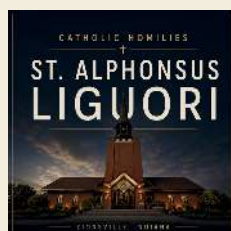
