"Throughout the ages, there have been so-called "private" revelations, some of which have been recognized by the authority of the Church. They do not belong, however, to the deposit of faith. It is not their role to improve or complete Christ's definitive Revelation, but to help live more fully by it in a certain period of history. Guided by the Magisterium of the Church, the sensus fidelium knows how to discern and welcome in these revelations whatever constitutes an authentic call of Christ or his saints to the Church."


"Ecclesiastical approval of a private revelation essentially means that its message contains nothing contrary to faith and morals; it is licit to make it public and the faithful are authorized to give to it their prudent adhesion. A private revelation can introduce new emphases, give rise to new forms of piety, or deepen older ones. It can have a certain prophetic character and can be a valuable aid for better understanding and living the Gospel at a certain time; consequently, it should not be treated lightly. It is a help which is proffered, but its use is not obligatory (Verbum Domini 14)." - Pope Benedict XVI








Rue du Bac, France (1830)

- Mary appeared to Catherine Laboure, a religious novitiate
- Mary asked her to have a medal made of her image - The Miraculous Medal
 - "All who wear it will receive great graces; they should wear it around the neck. Graces will abound for persons who wear it with confidence."
- · Mary foretold of political & church upheaval
- St. Catherine Laboure's body is incorrupt



- Mary appeared to Maximin Giraud (11) and Melanie Calvat-Mathieu (14)
- Mary's messages called for the urgency to turn from sin and repent
- A spring was found at the site and healings were attributed to the waters
- Controversy over "secrets"



Champion, W1 (1859)

- Mary appeared to Adele Brise and told her to evangelize & teach the faith
- Peshtigo Fire
 - Largest fire in US history 1.2 mil acres / 2,000 deaths
 - "a wall of flame, a mile high, five miles wide, traveling 90 to 100 miles an hour, hotter than a crematorium, turning sand into glass."
 - People gathered at the chapel & fire parted
- Bishop Ricken approved in 2010

- Mary appeared to Lucia de Santos (10), Francisco Marto (9), and Jacinta Marto (7) as Our Lady of the Rosary
- Mary asked for prayers for conversion of sinners
- Miracle of the Sun
- Secrets of Fatima
 - Vision of Hell
 - Foretelling of WWII, Communist Russia
 - Foretelling of persecution of Pope and the Church



Kibeho, Rawanda (1981-89)

- Mary appeared to Alphonsine (17), Nathalie (20), and Claire (21) calling for prayer & conversion
 - "These girls reported seeing a gruesome picture: a river of blood, people who killed one another, abandoned bodies with no one to bury them, a tree on fire, an open chasm, a monster, and severed heads."
- Various healings & miraculous signs were reported during apparitions
- Other alleged apparitions of Jesus by 3 other girls & a boy were not approved
