

First Holy Communion Dress Code

First Holy Communion is a sacred and momentous occasion symbolizing your child's initiation in the Eucharist. Please choose traditional and modest styles that reverently reflect the solemnity of the celebration.

Girls: white Dress, white knee socks, ankle socks or tights, dress shoes (no flip flops or sneakers)

Optional: veil, bow or crown of flowers in hair

Boys: dark (navy blue or black) long slacks, white dress shirt, tie, dress shoes (no sneakers)

Optional: suit jacket

Due to the distracting nature of extra items, please no gloves, flowers, books, rosary beads in hand or worn.

Pictures: Please do not take pictures *during* the holy sacrifice of the Mass. Please share this information with your family, relatives, and guests. You are welcome to take pictures after Mass.

A professional photographer will take a picture of your child receiving communion. We will provide a free 5x7 of this picture to you and will notify you when the pictures can be picked up in the Parish Office. You will also be provided with a link to the photographer's picture gallery approximately 2 weeks after all First Holy Communion Masses if you'd like to order more pictures.
