Q: How do I sign up as an adorer?

Q: What does it mean to be a Committed Adorer?

Adorers commit to adoring Jesus for an hour or more once a week. This is crucial since Jesus displayed in the monstrance must never be left alone. These Adorers enable us to have Eucharistic Adoration for any and all persons wanting to make a shorter visit to be with Jesus!

Q: Why am I being asked to sign in when I come to adore?

Adorers and Visitors should always check in when they arrive. We must ensure there are at least two adorers committed to each hour so that Jesus is not left alone in the chapel. By checking in when you arrive, it allows us to track numbers of adorers and monitor the health of the chapel.

Q: What happens if I arrive or leave and no one is in the chapel?



In a Eucharistic adoration chapel, a veil over the monstrance (the gold vessel holding Jesus) almost always means **the Eucharist is still there, but public exposition isn't actively taking place at that moment:**

- **If you arrive and the monstrance is veiled, genuflect,** and then reverently remove the veil and place it on the hat rack pictured here.
- **If you are leaving and there is no one else present,** do the above in reverse, and place the veil reverently over the monstrance.

Q: How should I enter and leave the chapel when the Blessed Sacrament is exposed on the altar?

When you are entering or leaving a place where Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is happening, the correct posture is to genuflect (kneel) on one knee.

Some people kneel on both knees; some people bow their head all the way to the ground; some lay flat on the ground. These are examples of personal pious actions but they are not required.

Q: Do I have to kneel the whole time?

While in prayer with the exposed Blessed Sacrament the correct posture is to kneel or to reverently sit.

Q: May I talk in the chapel during adoration?

If you are not the only adorer present, it is best to maintain a silent atmosphere to not disturb or distract from another's prayer. If you are the only one there, then yes, you may talk, pray or sing out loud!

Q: How do I request a substitute?

First, check if the person scheduled at the same time is planning to attend. If not, then you may request a sub by: 1. Login to your account and request a sub on your dashboard 2. Text sub to our adoration number 317-732-5777 or 3. Call the automated number and follow the prompts.

Q: If I get a sub request, do I have to decline or can I ignore it?

If you cannot accept a sub request, it's generally encouraged to decline it, but you don't have to.

Q: Can I sign up if there is no one needed at that time?

Yes! You can sign up at any hour you prefer; the more people that commit, the healthier the chapel. The reason we need two at each hour is to ensure Jesus is never alone.

Q: Can I change my adoration hour?

Yes! People move and some people just want or need a different time. Simply delete your hour and go to the schedule to select a new time and day.

Q: Can I have a different hour each week?

Yes! If you go to the calendar mode, you can select the week you want to adore. Once you click on the time and day you want to adore, you can select "once," "daily," "weekly," etc. Therefore, you could have a different hour each week if you would like.

Q: Can I be a substitute only?

Yes! Simply register as an adorer, and do not sign up for a specific hour and day. You will be contacted when someone makes a sub request.

Q: Do I have to adore for one hour?

No, there are options for as little as 5 minutes to as long as 2 hours. When you select a time slot on the calendar, it will give you the option to set the length of time.

Q: What happens if our schedules change or we go on vacation?

First, reach out to the other adorers at your time to see if they plan to attend. If so, then you do not need to request a sub. However, if they plan to be out as well, you can request a sub through your We Adore Him account.

What happens if the person scheduled after me does not show up?

If you are willing to stay, you are welcome to stay. If you need to leave, feel free to use the veil to cover the monstrance.

TEXT SHORTCUTS 317-732-5777	
SUB	Adorers can request a substitute for an upcoming commitment by texting the word SUB
YES-NO	When adorers receive an invitation to be a substitute, they can respond with YES to claim the substitute request or NO to decline it.
CODE	If your chapel requires a door code, adorers can send a text message of CODE or DOOR CODE to receive a message containing their door code.
VCARD	vCard - To easily add this phone number to your phone, request a vCard (it's like an electronic business card) by texting VCARD to the adoration phone number, which makes it much easier to recognize this phone number later.
STOP	To opt-out of receiving text messages, adorers may text the special STOP keyword.
START	You can text START to opt-in. If you aren't receiving texts, text the word START.
HELP	Text HELP to read basic information about your adoration program.
HELLO	Text HELLO for a simple validation that the site recognizes your phone number.
