FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR: Happy Lent! We began on Ash Wednesday with the call from God through the prophet Joel to"return to me with your whole heart" and the prayer of today's Psalm: "Be merciful, O Lord, for we have sinned." The call to reform, renew, and reconcile [the 3 Rs] our lives to the will of God is always given to us. Lent invites us to stop and to make a closer examination of our lives as we journey to the Cross.

During the Season of Lent, I will be using the Eucharistic Prayer for Reconciliation I and we will resume chanting the Lord's Prayer. Please join Deacon Greg and me for Masses, Adoration/Benediction, Stations of the Cross, and other spiritual opportunities during Lent. Please check out our schedule for Lent/Easter attached to last Sunday's bulletin and on our website. More information of the assignment of priests may be found on the parish website and in the March 9 The Catholic Globe. These changes take place on June 27. On that day, Fr. Kevin Richter becomes the Pastor of all twelve [12] parishes in Carroll County with four Parochial Vicars [Associate Pastors]. The status of all twelve [12] parishes remain unchanged until the entire Ministry 2025 process is completed—perhaps a year or more from today. This process will begin for us in August with the facilitated planning meetings with the priests, deacons, and representatives from all the parishes. The next step will be a revision of Mass schedule for all twelve [12] parishes to begin July 1. Otherwise, it is business as usual for all twelve [12] parishes.
