FROM THE PRIESTS: We Frs. Tims understand that the changes that all of our parishes will experience this coming year are difficult and deeply saddening. There is no parish in the entire diocese who has not experienced some change throughout the process of diocesan-wide pastoral planning. It is important to grieve the losses that this process involves. It saddens us, too, to acknowledge that in years to come there will be more changes in the diocese in order to make it possible for the fewer and fewer active priests to provide pastoral ministry to the People of God of the Diocese of Sioux City.

The decline in the number of active priests has been a decades long decline. In that time, we've also seen the number of people in NW Iowa decline. One can easily see where there are abandoned farm places where (large) families used to live and work. That has also resulted in a decline of the number of Catholics in our diocese. We can also include the decline in the percentage of Catholic people who attend weekend and Holy Day Masses—even before the COVID pandemic. All of these factors play a role in the diocesan pastoral planning.

This is the reality with which our diocese has to deal; by "diocese", we don't simply mean, Bishop Nickless, or the staff in the Central Catholic Offices, or the priests and deacons. All of them and all the Catholic faithful comprise the Diocese of Sioux City. Much of the reality with which we must deal is not of our choosing—nor did any one of us directly cause it. Nevertheless, **each of us can choose our attitude and our actions going forward.** Please, please, choose faith; choose the Good Shepherd. Choose communal worship and activities of the new Good Shepherd Catholic Parish. Choose continued faith formation for our youth through religious education programs and Kueper Catholic Schools. Choose service and generous stewardship of time, talent and treasure. These and so much more are our Lord's ways (see the Responsorial Psalm). Teach us Lord, how to be faithful to you in these difficult times. Help us, too, O Lord, to invite and welcome back people who have not been active in their parishes so that they can be nourished by your Word and Sacrament and build up our community of faith!

THE THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME, YEAR B

Readings: Jonah 3:1-5, 10; Psalm 25:4-5, 6-7, 8-9 (R: "Teach me your ways, O Lord."); 1 Corinthians 7:29-31; Mk 1:14-20

We miss the "fun" part of the Book of Jonah today, for our reading picks up after Jonah flees, rather than do the LORD's bidding to go to Nineveh to preach a message of repentance. We miss Jonah on a boat which is being tossed about on the sea until the crew, by drawing lots, realize Jonah is the problem. With Jonah's urging, they toss him into the sea. A big fish swallows Jonah, which gives him the occasion to rethink running from the LORD's call; he turns to the LORD in prayer. Then the big fish spews him up on the beach. Now, finally, he heads to Nineveh, which was the capital of Assyria, Israel's archenemy. By the way, Jonah didn't refuse to go Nineveh because he was afraid. Rather, he knew that they would repent and God would forgive them. He didn't want that, because his animus against his enemies was so great.

The story of Jonah is juxtaposed against the quickness with which the four fishermen, Peter, Andrew, James and John, respond to the call of Jesus. We might also remember the Gospel of John's version of the call of the first disciples (who will be named apostles) from last week. In that version, Andrew is in the midst of being a disciple of John the Baptist; today Jesus's call comes in the midst of the fishermen's daily activity. In both Gospels the emphasis is on how the Lord's call comes in the midst of what we are doing. Unlike Jonah, when the Lord calls us, in the midst of whatever we are doing, he wants us to respond quickly, unreservedly, in faith, in the present. St. Paul gives an even more heightened sense of urgency: "I tell you, brothers and sisters, the time is running out. ... For the world in its present form is passing away" (1 Cor. 7:29a, 31b). "Teach [us] your ways, O Lord" (Psalm response), so that we may respond when you call and do what you ask of us!
