RAGBRAI baked goods update – After speaking with the state food inspector again, we have learned that we can in fact have people make baked goods at their own residence to sell at the Good Shepherd RAGBRAI stand. We will still be exempt from licensing and able

to sell the items under the "Cottage Food" code. However, each food item MUST be individually packaged and labeled at the residence in which it was made. The label has many requirements, such as identification of the name and address/phone number of person preparing the food, the ingredients, identification of any allergens, and a statement that "This product was produced at a residential property that is exempt from state licensing and inspection." The inspector reiterated that the baked goods MUST be packed and labeled before they leave the residence. Due to this development, we will not be meeting at the Mary Nieland Center on July 22. Instead, volunteers are asked to let Becky Vonnahme know how many dozen cookies or rice krispie bars they plan to make in their own residence. We will arrange a pickup/drop off of all baked goods for Sunday, July 23, to have ready for sale on Monday. For more information, contact Becky Vonnahme at 712-210-4974.
