Fr. Roder **will not** have mass January 1-3 (Mon.-Wed.). He will be back for mass on Thursday, Jan. 4 (Breda).

Since the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God falls on a Monday (New Year's Day), it is not considered a holy day of obligation this year.

ATTENTION REGARDING WINTER WEATHER AND WEEKDAY MASSES--if school is delayed or cancelled, there will be no weekday Mass offered that day. Also, the Parish office will probably be closed or at the very least open later on bad weather days. It's best to call ahead on those days.

PERSONS WISHING TO JOIN THE CATHOLIC CHURCH, whether baptized in another faith or unbaptized and over the age of seven [7], may contact Fr. Roder at any time of the year to begin the process known as the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA), or the Rite of Christian Initiation of Children (RCIC).
