ASH WEDNESDAY MASSES & SERVICES: Mass will be held at 7:30am at Sacred Heart, Templeton, 8am at St. John, Arcadia (in the rectory), 12noon at St. John, Arcadia (scripture readings and distribution of ashes only) and at 5:30pm at St. Bernard, Breda. Even though it is not a holy day of obligation, it is an important way to start our Lenten journey. May these 40 days of Lent draw us closer to our Savior and the one who loves us most in this life. Roman Catholics must fast and abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Additionally, they must abstain from meat on all Fridays during Lent. The norms of fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. Fasting means a person is permitted to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may also be taken, but they are not to equal that of a full meal. The rule of abstinence from meat is binding upon Catholics aged 14 and onwards.

THE ANNUAL COLLECTION FOR AID TO GLOBAL CHURCHES will be held on the First Sunday of Lent, February 17-18. You are invited to participate in the special collection to benefit the Church in Africa, Latin America, and Eastern Europe, and the bishops' charity organization CRS to help build churches and schools, train and educate priests and laypeople, publish Catholic newspapers, sustain orphanages, evangelize, and catechize children and adults, and provide scholarships to Catholic students. Thank you for your generosity to make a difference in building up the Church in Central and Eastern Europe, Africa, Latin America, and other places in need of our assistance.
