A reminder: Whenever one of the parish churches has a funeral scheduled, the 8am mass will be <u>cancelled</u>. Fr. Remmes will only cancel the 8am mass if the funeral is held at St. John.

There will not be **Eucharistic Adoration** on **Friday, April 5** at 8:30am in Halbur, <u>BUT</u> we will have Adoration at **6pm in Breda**.

Templeton Church Work & Change in Mass Location: Replacement of the main entrance stairs and concrete on the north and east sides of Sacred Heart church will begin after Easter, which will necessitate a change in mass location for a couple weeks. ST. BERNARD, BREDA

Due to the significant debt that Good Shepherd Catholic Parish is faced with, the finance council has begun exploring options to reduce expenses at its many parish properties. Our top priority is ensuring our beautiful worship sites are properly maintained. Because parish funeral receptions in Breda are held at the Legion Hall, the former St. Bernard school building in Breda is rarely utilized other than a small percentage of space for the parish office, and sporadic rentals for family events or sports teams. The second floor is not available for rental, nor is it currently heated. On top of monthly operating expenses, along with yearly insurance premiums, the building is now in need of a new roof at a substantial cost. We feel the building is still a good structure and could potentially benefit the community in another capacity, while reducing our financial burden. Therefore, the parish is open to speaking with developers or investors who have an interest in repurposing the building to better serve the community. This is just an exploratory phase right now to see if an alternative use is feasible, and no formal timeline is set for making any decisions.
