When they were planted over 20 years ago, every other tree was one of two varieties including blue spruce and Norway spruce. Over the last few years, the Norway spruce trees have become thin and needed to be removed. We will get the spaces leveled and seeded this fall, and in a few years after everything has settled we will likely plant new trees in the gaps. This way we will have a rotating cycle as trees near the end of their lives and we will always have a nice row of trees to line the road. Special thanks to Dan & Cass Weitl and Rich, Chris and Matt Danner for their hard work and equipment to get this needed work done so quickly and efficiently!

Templeton Church Painting/Weekday Mass Location Change: We are planning to have Riehle Decorating in town the first several weeks of August to repair plaster and paint in church where there were roof leaks over the past several years. Riehle's did the original painting and decorating in 2010 so we are confident they will do a great job to address these repairs.
