When they were planted over 20 years ago, every other tree was one of two varieties including blue spruce and Norway spruce. Over the last few years, the Norway spruce trees have become thin and needed to be removed. We will get the spaces leveled and seeded this fall, and in a few years after everything has settled we will likely plant new trees in the gaps. This way we will have a rotating cycle as trees near the end of their lives and we will always have a nice row of trees to line the road. PERSONS WISHING TO JOIN THE CATHOLIC CHURCH, whether baptized in another faith or unbaptized and over the age of seven [7], may contact Fr. Roder at any time of the year to begin the process known as the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA), or the Rite of Christian Initiation of Children (RCIC).

If either the bride or the groom was previously married and has not yet done the annulment process, that will be necessary before marriage preparation can begin. Please contact Fr. Roder so that all preparations may be completed in time for the wedding and marriage. Remember, the wedding is just a day, while marriage is a LIFETIME!
