The Good Shepherd Finance Council has been working hard to address the debt owed to Kuemper. The Council is happy to announce that all of the St. Bernard and Sacred Heart past debt to Kuemper has been paid off and all but \$223,494 of the \$811,029 owed from Good Shepherd for the 2022-23 school year has been paid. However, \$75,343 is still owed on the St. Augustine past debt as well as Good Shepherd's assessment of \$635,699 for the 2023-34 school year. Good Shepherd's August 2024 payment of \$48,611 toward the 2024-25 school year is also now due. We are thankful for your continued support of Good Shepherd Parish and Kuemper Catholic School.

Former St. Bernard Endowment Update: It has come to the attention of the Finance Council and Directors that there may be some confusion regarding the former St. Bernard's Endowment Fund and the status of that moving forward. To clarify, this fund was set up many years ago as a way to help fund various needs of St. Bernard and the former Christ the King School. There was a separate board that oversaw the investment of the funds and made contributions back to the church from the income generated from investments. The Good Shepherd finance board and directors have been working for the last two years to understand all the assets and liabilities of each of the six former parishes that were merged together, including the St. Bernard fund. Because St. Bernard is no longer a legal corporation in either the Catholic Church or in the State of Iowa, steps are necessary to make sure the fund can continue to help with the current needs of the merged Good Shepherd Catholic Parish, which is now the active legal entity in the Church and State of Iowa. This has been the case with assets for all of the former individual parishes. To clarify, the former St. Bernard funds will continue to be used strictly for the benefit of GSCP in accordance with the current and future needs of the parish, and are not being sent to the Sioux City Diocese for any other reason. This name change of the fund reflects the direction of the bylaws that were created many years ago with several contingencies in case St. Bernard ever ceased to exist. If anyone has any questions, please feel free to contact a GSCP Finance Board member or director.
