FORMER ST. BERNARD SCHOOL BUILDING UPDATE:

The Good Shepherd Catholic Parish Finance Council will begin accepting formal proposals for the purchase and possible renovation of the former St. Bernard school property. A Request for Proposal form must be must be completed with the bid and can be obtained by emailing goodshepherd@westianet.net. The Finance Council will only consider proposals that explain how the building will be utilized to provide a clear benefit to the community of Breda and the surrounding area. (For example, recreational purposes, housing or business ventures that fill identified needs). If there are no proposals that meet these criteria, the Finance Council will hold on to the property to explore other options. All interested parties should return the completed proposals by Tuesday, December 3, 2024. To schedule a tour of the facility, contact Becky Vonnahme at 712-210-4974.

**UPDATE ON GSCP DEBT:** Parish members will soon receive a copy of the GSCP Annual Report documenting finances for fiscal year July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024. When you review this report, you will note encouraging progress has been made on payment of past debt to Kuemper. For example, all past debt from Our Lady of Mt. Carmel, St. Bernard, and Sacred Heart, has now joined St. John's as being completely paid off. This is great news and reason to celebrate! And, on another positive note, parishioner donations are on track to cover current operating expenses moving forward. The bad news is that Good Shepherd Catholic Parish still owes nearly \$1 million in past assessment debt that continues to

negatively impact Kuemper's budget. While we are confident future assessments will be reduced, we can't ignore this past debt. Without a substantial increase in donations from all parishioners, the GSCP Finance Council will have no choice other than to explore the possibility of selling some assets. This could include telephone stock and non-church buildings that have value. Our parishion-

ers have done a fantastic job coming together and building this new parish community, and we feel strongly that the future is very bright for meeting our financial obligations. However, as difficult as it will be, we must meet our duty to pay this overdue debt.
