Dear Parents,

[The location of these meetings has been selected where a great number of candidates reside.] At least one parent is to attend one of these meetings. Please choose one of these meetings to attend. If you are unable attend one of these meetings, please let me know asap.

During each meeting, we will present the responsibilities of parents and child, the purpose and significance of the Sacrament of Reconciliation, and the dates for celebration of First Reconciliation.

In January, we will offer meetings to help prepare for First Holy Communion, which will be held April 2019 in the children's home parishes at the Sunday Mass.

During this time, I hope this will be a spiritually rewarding experience for both you and your child as you work together through this program as you take advantage of the possibilities that this year brings as we grow in our commitment to our Faith.
