- 5. First Communicants will be asked to help serve as readers and gift bearers at their First Eucharist Mass. Readers and gift bearers will rehearse at the rehearsal.
- 6. **PHOTOS** [group and individual (including with the priest)] will be taken by parents or persons selected by the parents at the following time on the day of Holy Communion:
