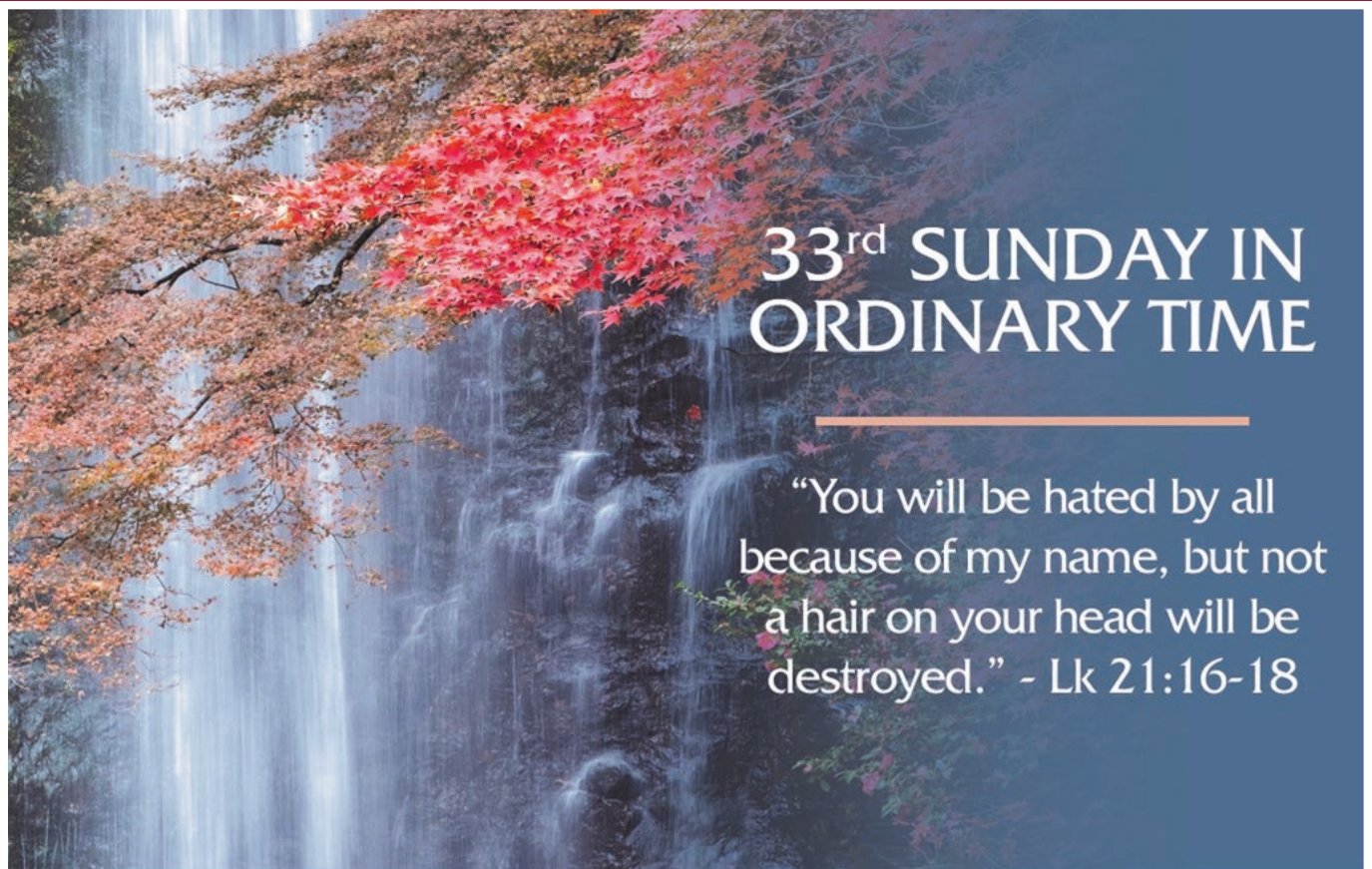

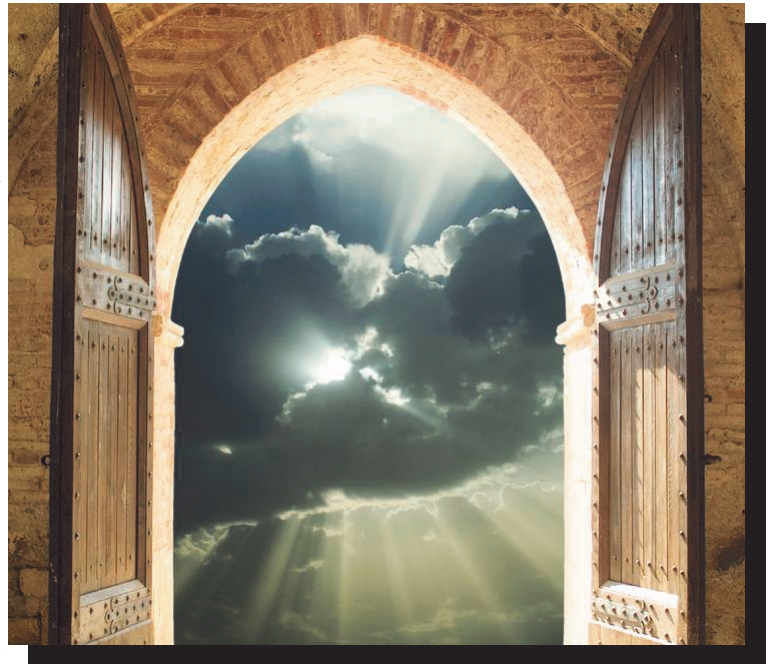


From Our Associate Pastor

My Dear and Precious Friends,

After so many months of meetings and planning for our future together as a new parish family, this weekend we see the first fruits of our labor as we celebrate our Unity Mass. I cannot even begin to tell you how very much I have been looking forward to this day, and how very much I thank you all for working so hard together to make this new day in the life of our new parish possible! However, this special celebration is only a milestone on our journey together. As our Holy Father Pope Francis teaches us, opening wide the doors of our new parish is not enough. As we celebrate this special moment together, we must redouble our efforts to find new roads, to step outside of our church and reach out to our brothers and sisters who no longer attend Mass, to those who have decided to quit or who have become indifferent. And so it is with great sadness that, after 18 years of service to our parish family, John Ligda has made the decision to move on to a new future. John had become much more than our director of sacred music. He worked tirelessly behind the scenes in every aspect of our liturgical life, becoming a source of unity and inspiration for our many parish ministries. I first met John when he was in grade school. He attended Quigley Seminary's Summer Program, which I had the privilege of directing, to explore the possibility of a vocation to the priesthood. While he decided not to enter the seminary, he went on to Brother Rice High School, and then in 2004 earned his Bachelor of Arts degree in music from Saint Joseph College. He came to our parish and became our music director fresh from college. He continued his study of music at Saint Joseph College, earning his Master of Arts degree in 2006. He expanded his horizons, going on to study Mortuary Science, and in 2010 graduated with an Associate Degree in Applied Science from Worsham College. In addition to his many years of service here

with us, he has become the director of his own funeral service, serves as the president of Trade Service Professionals, and is also a consultant and innovator at Frigid Fluid Company. As a fellow musician, I would like to add that John is one of the most gifted organists it has ever been my pleasure to know. We will miss John and the many gifts that he has brought to our parish family over the years. We wish him well as he continues his work as a liturgist and musician, and as he continues to touch so many families in grief in his work as a funeral director. May God bless him with much happiness and success!

Around the Parish

From the Desk of the Director of Music

"It was not you who chose me, but I who chose you and appointed you to go and bear fruit that will remain" John 15:16

This weekend is an historic moment for the Catholic church in the south suburbs. The former Saint Joseph church is formally united into one new parish with many hearts and voices praying for a renewal that will hopefully mature into a stronger, vibrant Catholic presence in our communities. We have been chosen to literally renew our Baptismal commitment as one family of believers journeying together toward eternity. It is a journey I had expected to walk with you, until recently learning that God was calling me to another mission in His church.

For the last eighteen years I have been privileged to share in your life through the ministry of music and liturgy. Every moment has been a blessing far beyond anything I had ever imagined. Each of you have played a pivotal role in my professional and spiritual development. In many ways, you have ministered to me more than I ministered to you. And so it is with a heavy heart that I share the news of my departure as your Organist and Director of Music. I have accepted a similar position in a parish in the southwest suburbs that is to begin this week.

I would be remis if I did not extend my deepest appreciation to those persons who were instrumental in bringing us and keeping us together these many years:

- Father Richard Kozak, the Sixth Pastor of Saint Joseph Parish, for his dedication to music and liturgy and asking me to join him as a member of the parish staff;
- Dick Marzullo who Chaired my Search Committee and who saw something special in me, along with Bertrand Ellis and the late Jackie Silkowski both of whom were dedicated representatives of our parish choir;
- the late Dan and Jan Coffey who were tremendously generous with their time, talent and treasure always making sure the music program was meeting its potential;
- my fellow staff member and the former Director of Religious Education Maureen Kelly who helped me grow as an educator and Catechist;
- I am grateful to Father Bob Kyfes, Seventh Pastor of Saint Joseph Parish for his leadership and trust in me through the last six years of his presbyterial career;
- Ruth Austing who not only maintains our parish choral and instrumental libraries, but who responds to every request with a "yes." (I would have been lost with her assistance);
- and finally to those generous, talented and loving members of the parish music program, most especially the *Festival Choir* who donate hundreds of hours of their time and talents year-after-year to ensuring Liturgy is a reverent and prayerful encounter with our Lord.

Saying "goodbye" or "farewell" seems inappropriate because after eighteen years our lives are deeply intertwined. I have every belief that our paths will continue to cross. And even though my new assignment will keep me busy, I am always just a phone call or an email away. If nothing else, you should be able to find me though my funeral home just 10-minutes north of the parish on Western Avenue or by calling (708) 385-0634.

In closing, I wish to impart on you one of my favorite prayers from the Roman Missal - the Solemn Blessing over the people during the season of Advent. It captures the reality of our pilgrimage and our goal for this life – Heaven. This is my parting prayer for each of you:

As you run the race of this present life, may the Lord make you firm in faith, joyful in hope and active in charity. So that, rejoicing now with devotion at the Redeemer's coming in the flesh, you may be endowed with the rich reward of eternal life when he comes again in majesty. May Almighty God bless you, in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

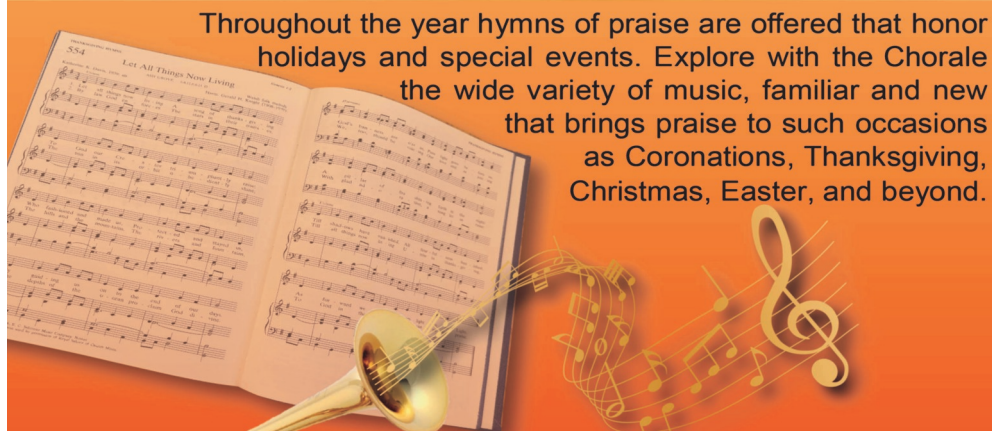
