

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ at St. John the Beloved Disciple and St. Joseph,

We have been working very hard over the last 6 months and beyond to welcome new families and to build a culture of discipleship at both parishes. In some very simple numbers, the efforts are paying off. At St. John the Beloved, we have welcomed 11 new families over the last year and at St. Joseph, we have welcomed 147 new families. That said, it's hard to believe but Lent is just 10 days away! Are you ready? Am I ready? To make this Lenten season intentionally sacrificial and prayerful, filling us with the love, the mercy and the grace of Almighty God, to prepare to share the Good News of Jesus Christ. "Lenten Program, No Greater Love: A Biblical Walk Through Christ's Passion."


