

## Interested in participating more fully in the Mass? Become a Eucharistic Minister

Soon we will once again be offering the Precious Blood at Mass. Therefore, an opportunity has opened up to recruit more Eucharistic Ministers. To begin offering the Precious Blood, three Eucharistic Ministers are needed for each weekend Mass (unless a deacon accompanies the priest, then two are needed), and one Eucharistic Minister at weekday Masses. Training will be provided. The Archdiocesan requirements for a Eucharistic Minister are:

- •Possess a love of the Eucharist and exhibit a moral manner consistent with the discipline, norms, and teachings of the Church.
- •Be at least 18 years old.
- •Have completed the sacraments of initiation, i.e. baptism, confirmation, and First Eucharist.


