SUMMER WORK BEING DONE

Over the Summer Months we will be undertaking several projects to keep up the beautiful buildings we are blessed with here at Annunciation Parish. The green metal roof of Holy Rosary Church will be painted to ensure it continues to keep out the weather. We will also make some repairs to the roof of the Holy Rosary rectory and remove an unused chimney that is leaking. The largest project this summer will be the replacement of the boiler at Holy Rosary Church to a more efficient Natural Gas model. This is anticipated to have saving in both fuel and maintenance. At Holy Spirit we are continuing to investigate the seepage of water into the basement and develop a plan to rectify this issue. These updates are made possible through the generosity of you, the parishioners. We hope you will continue to give to our restoration and maintenance funds so we can continue to be good stewards of the properties and Churches. We will keep you updated as these projects are started and make you aware of any changes to parking or entering and exiting the buildings as this work unfolds.


