

# From the Pastor's Desk

HAPPY EASTER! Today we celebrate the day when Jesus rose from the dead. This event is so important because it shows us that the most final thing we think of in life, the thing that so many people fear, is no match for God. We are told that if we are joined to Jesus through Baptism and remain united to him that we rise with him. Today is a day to rejoice, a day to be happy, a day to look at the wonderful promise we have in Jesus Christ. 
