

# **PASTOR'S MESSAGE**

# "The Lord said to Elijah:

"You shall anoint Elisha, son of Shaphat of Abelmeholah, as prophet to succeed you.... Elijah went over to him and threw his cloak over him.... Then Elisha left and followed Elijah as his attendant." From I Kings 19:16b, 19-21

As I write my last Pastor's Message for the good people of St. Matthew's Parish, I couldn't have selected a more appropriate set of readings to say farewell. As I pass on the pastorship to a good friend, Father Eric Ritter, it seems like just a short while back when I was meeting with Msgr. Michael Yarbrough and he was handing me a stack of papers for me to review as he passed the torch of leadership to me. In today's First Reading from I Kings 19, Elijah is nearing his departure from this world and is passing his mantle onto Elisha. We recall that when asked what he wished for, Elisha did not seek gold or power or fame but a double portion of the great prophet's spirit. Indeed Elijah had selected well.

When Msgr. Mike and Fr. Eric and I were ordained to the diocesan priesthood we solemnly placed our hands within those of the bishop and promised obedience to him and his successor. In today's Gospel from Luke 9:51-62, Jesus tells the man who says, "I will follow you wherever you go", that unlike the foxes and birds who have dens and nests, the Son of Man has no permanent place to rest. So we were ordained to be itinerant, albeit not as itinerant as Jesus was, who moved frequently from village to village, but nonetheless on the move. There's a beauty to obedience, opening your life to a new chapter, a new part of our Archdiocese, a new set of neighborhoods, settings and people to start afresh yet with the old familiar pattern of what we do as priests: preach, anoint, listen, pray and travel on the journey of faith with God's people.

In looking back 12 years I have without a doubt been enriched by all of the encounters I have had

with you, the parishioners and staff of St. Matthew's Parish and School. While it has been a joy to have renovated the church and made a mark on the physical plant of our parish, what I treasure the most is walking with you as a companion on the journey of faith: to minister with the dying and those who are grieving, to baptize your newborn child or grandchild as we welcome them into our world and Church, to anoint those in need of God's healing grace, to be so humbled as to hear you bear your soul in a confession: this is what I will remember and treasure. I will miss you all greatly, and I do love you!

So on to the parish of another evangelist, St. Mark, where a new chapter will be written. I will pray for you, and I humbly ask that you pray for me, as I hold tight to the beautiful memories of a place I was blessed to be a part of and will never forget!



This is a difficult reading and an even more difficult challenge. Jesus calls us to follow him—without hesitation or exception. Sometimes we respond to God's call like the person who says, "I will . . . but first . . . ." We put conditions on our discipleship. We may practice our faith but only when it is convenient. Total commitment is difficult. We can only hope to be successful because Jesus has gone before us to show us the way. We must walk in his footsteps and pray for his help.

What kind of person do you think leaves everything to follow Jesus? What do you think it means to leave everything behind? Have you sometimes put something else before God? Reflect on the reasons why. What are some reasons why we hesitate to commit fully to following Jesus? How can we overcome these hesitations? The path of discipleship is one that requires the disciple to make sacrifices to truly follow Jesus. At the end of each Mass, the presider or deacon tells us to go out into the world and live our lives according to the Gospel. Pray about what that means in your lives. What sacrifices can you make to respond properly to your baptismal call of discipleship?

# **DISCIPLESHIP'S COSTS**

In today's first reading, God tells the prophet Elijah to prepare Elisha to succeed him. Succeeding Elijah will be no easy task; he has spent his life facing threats from the kings he has confronted about their infidelity to the God of Israel. The psalm illustrates the emotional and spiritual distress that the prophets' steadfast faithfulness to God brought them. Paul's description of the Christian's freedom from the law as opposed to "the desire of the flesh" puts this struggle at the very heart of Christian identity. The reading from Luke's Gospel recounts Jesus' decision to journey toward Jerusalem, where he knows he will meet his earthly fate. Following Jesus—like succeeding Elijah as prophet—will now become more difficult. Unlike his calls to the first disciples, Jesus encounters those who are not ready or are not strong enough to journey with him. Copyright © J. S. Paluch Co.




