PASTOR'S CORNER

The second Sunday of Advent introduces the ministry of St. John the Baptist, whose ministry is described in all four Gospels. This chapter is packed with multiple references to the Old Testament, which has been completely fulfilled by the coming of Jesus. The Baptist is described as the forerunner of the Messiah who was prophesied in the Old Testament as the prophet Elijah who would come again and announce that the long-awaited Messiah had finally arrived. The Baptist looked and acted like the popular expectation for prophets, and he 'fit' the image of the expected forerunner. His rough clothing of camel haircloth with a leather belt is the same clothing worn by Elijah. He eats locusts and wild honey, in stark contrast to the luxurious lifestyles of the Jewish



leadership. He lives in the desert wilderness, announcing the coming Messiah ('the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand') in fulfillment of the 'voice crying in the wilderness', preparing the way of the coming Lord, in the prophecy of Isaiah. He is widely accepted by the Israelites as a prophet. He preaches a stern message of repentance and austerity, characteristic of the Old Testament prophets. This section introduces another key term in this Gospel, the Kingdom of Heaven, which is used 32 times in this Gospel. The Kingdom of Heaven refers to God's covenantal promise to establish King David's royal kingdom forever, except that it is spiritualized in this Gospel. The sacred author therefore undercuts the popular expectation that the Messiah will be a military and political savior who will restore the earthly kingdom of King David in Israel. The Kingdom of Heaven begins on earth with the Incarnation of Jesus and will reach its full potential in eternal life with Jesus in heaven. The Jordan River is yet another powerful symbol. It is not just a river for the Jews. It was a powerful symbol of new life and hope. In the Old Testament, the Jordan River is associated with God's deliverance of the ancient Israelites in the time of Joshua. St. John's baptism of water in the Jordan River is another important symbol. His baptism was a baptism of purification and a symbol of repentance in preparation for the coming Messiah. Scholars believe that converts to Judaism were baptized as a sign of ritual cleansing from the impure lifestyles and diets of the pagan Gentiles. The Biblical understanding of repentance is to turn around and return to God. The Baptist is therefore calling for a total change in mind and behavior, not just a ritual cleansing. He is calling the People of God to a radically new direction of their lives, away from habitual sin and a return to the Lord. The Judean desert was also a powerful symbol for the Jews. To reach the site of John's baptism, pilgrims would have had to travel about twenty miles through a hot, rugged, and barren wilderness. Traversing the desert becomes a metaphor for the Exodus of the ancient Hebrew people from slavery in Egypt, on their way to a new and abundant life in the Promised Land. The Baptist was therefore calling the People of God into a new Exodus from the slavery of sin and to reenter the Promised Land of holiness where they could be in communion with God once again. The desert is the place where one meets God and experiences His love and mercy. Advent is our opportunity to enter our desert to prepare our hearts for the coming of the Lord.







Europe-In Alpine countries, children carry a statue of St. Joseph to a different home each night during Advent.

Middle East-Named after St. Barbara who is said to have been martyred in Egypt, a twig from a fruit tree, usually a cherry, is placed in water. If the "Barbara branch" blooms on or before Christmas day, the family will have good fortune. This custom recalls the prophesy in Isaiah that the Messiah will spring from the root of Jesse.

China-Colorful paper lanterns are hung in Christian homes during Advent.


