

Jim Schmitmeyer jokes that one night he wants to go and paint the words St. Thomas over the word "More." I wonder how they picked the name for the Church. I have a feeling it has something to do with the search for meaning. Isn't it the main question of our life? "Is there more?" The sign itself indicates that is you are looking for the answer that building just might be a location to answer your question.

"To carry out such a task, the Church has always had the duty of scrutinizing the signs of the times and of interpreting them in the light of the Gospel. Thus, in language intelligible to each generation, she can respond to the perennial questions which men ask about this present life and the life to come, and about the relationship of the one to the other. We must therefore recognize and understand the world in which we live, its explanations, its longings, and its often dramatic characteristics." Gaudium et spes 4.

Maybe you ask the questions about life's vocation, or God's will for your life? The questions of life have answers, deep life giving answers that can only be found in a relationship with Jesus Christ. In Him we find all the "More" we could ever need.


