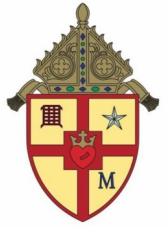

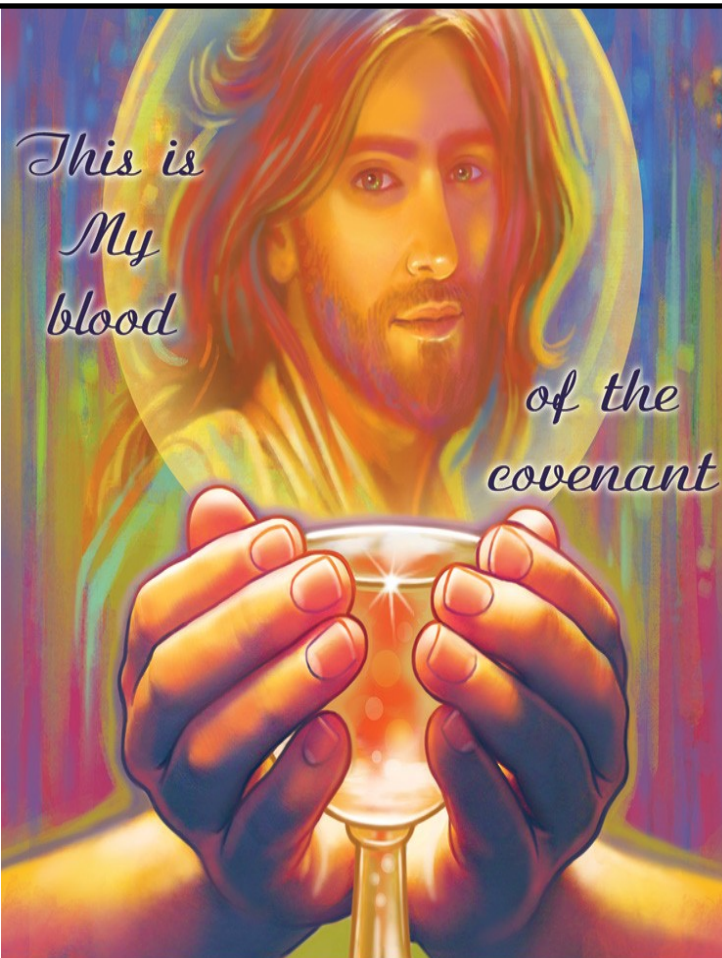

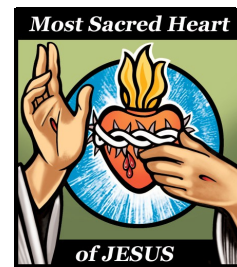


We want to remind people to feel free to use the parish prayer lines when needs arise in your
