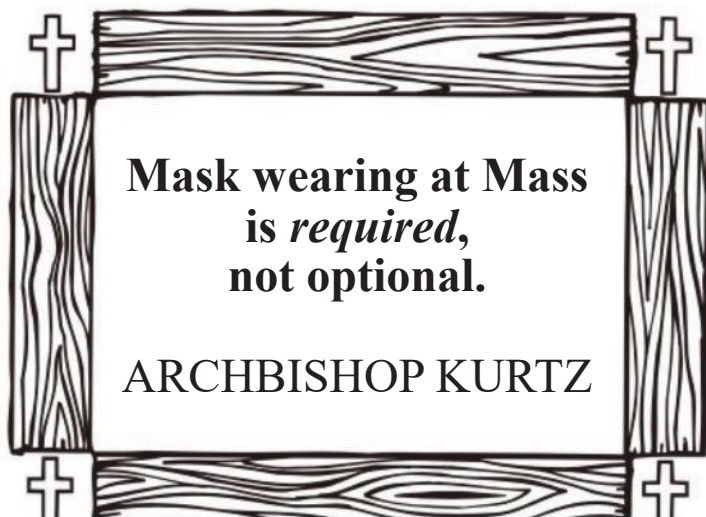

**Parish Pastoral Council Minutes (May 5, 2021)**

*Present– Fr. Terry Bradshaw, Laura Ebelhar, Betty Kaye Hayden, Jim Luckett, Kerry Monin, Donna Pascal and Payton Ulrich*

- 1) April minutes were reviewed and approved.
- 2) Nomination Plan for new Parish council members was discussed
  - ~Nominations begin in May and close June 1<sup>st</sup>. An orientation and lottery will be held if there is a surplus of nominees. There can be up to 12 members.
  - ~New Parish Council members will begin in September
- 3) The Budget Report was reviewed
  - ~The Church is projected to be in the “black” for 20-21 due to the Payroll Protection Program (PPP) funding for 8 weeks of salary. Support for the Church did not drop as much as feared. The parish is budgeted to be in the “red” for 21-22 but if donations pick-up and the Super Raffle does better than we expect, we will be in the black. (We have not been able to save funds for depreciation and those expenditures will come due at some point.)
  - ~SJS is projected to be in the “black” due to the PPP funds for 2020-21 and to recover loses for 2019-20 (due to Covid),. This coming year school budget is balanced with some adjustments in staffing.
  - ~SVDP Mission Store and the Bread of Life Food Pantry projected to have a balanced budget for 21-22 (without funding normal depreciation).
  - ~Because the PPP Loan was forgiven, this gave a great relief related to 8 weeks of salaries for school, parish, Montessori, SVDP, and the cemetery.
- 4) After discussing, council members recommended Fr. Terry accept the prepared budget report.
- 5) The process for staffing and the status of currently open job positions was discussed
- 6) The 2021 Super Raffle was briefly discussed and Fr. Terry made note that the Parish Council is needed to take the lead on this fundraiser again. The drawing will be held in September.

The Archbishop expects consultation and support by the Parish Pastoral Council for annual budget proposal, major expenditures and projects, or other significant parish decisions.
