

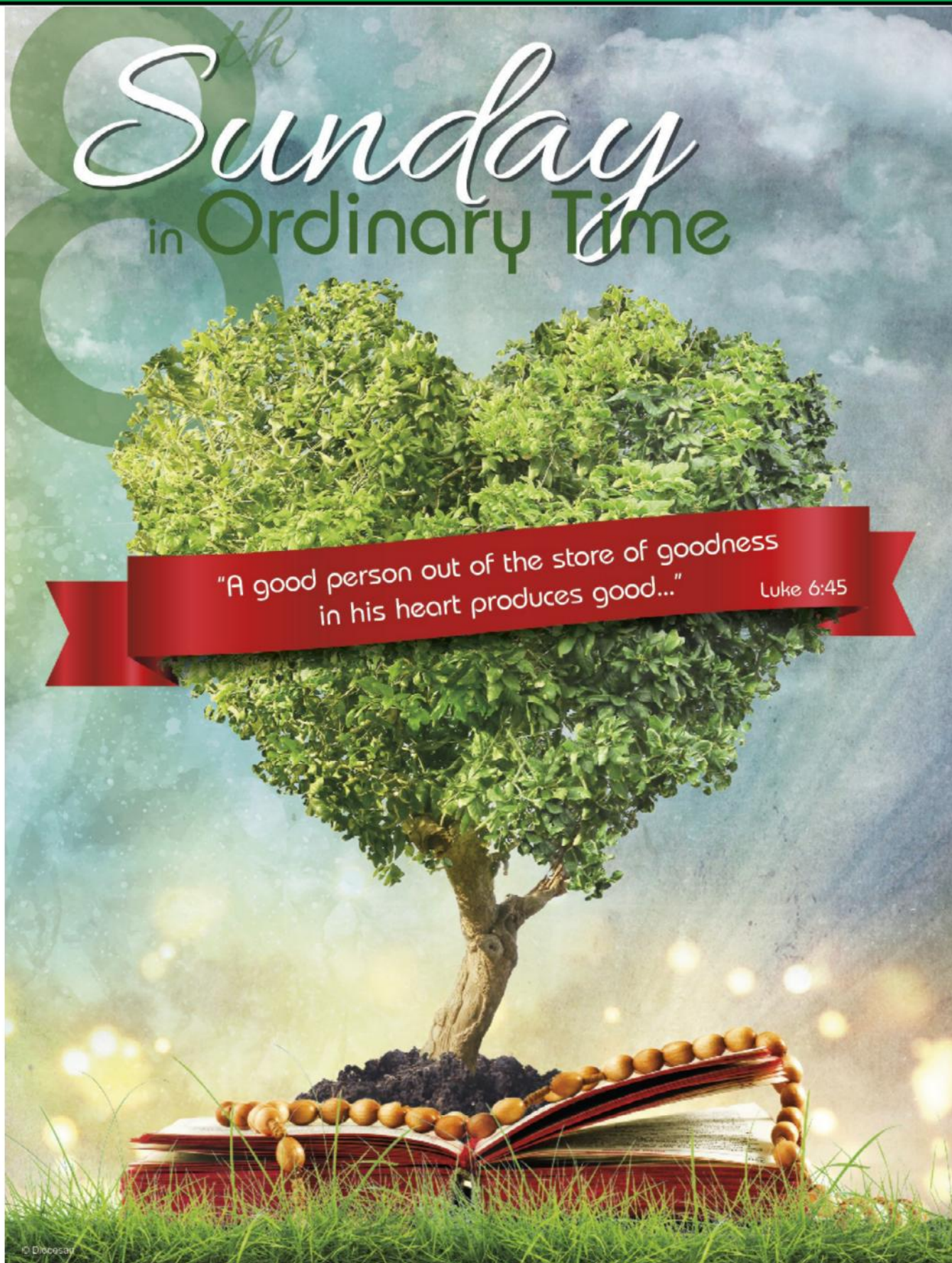

Automatic Bill Pay

An automatic bill payment is a money transfer scheduled on a predetermined date to pay a recurring amount. Automatic bill payments are routine payments made from a banking, brokerage, or mutual fund account to St Joseph. Automatic payments are made through your own personal bank's online banking program and typically are offered with no additional bank fee.

Lenten Observances

On Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays of Lent: All persons of age 14 years and older must abstain from consuming meat.

On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, all persons aged 18 to 59 must fast, unless exempt due to a medical reason. A Lenten fast means a person is permitted to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may be taken, but the two are not to equal a full meal (i.e., lite breakfast, lite lunch with a full dinner).

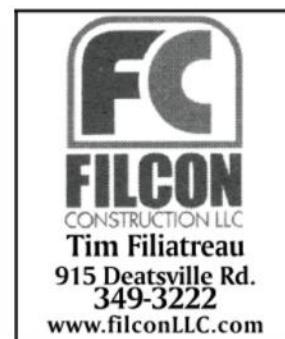

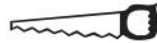
