### **Teaching Mass**



# **Day of Prayer for Harmony**

Bishop Robert Reed, who serves as bishop for our West Region of the Archdiocese of Boston, has asked us to be one of the host churches for a "Day of Prayer for Harmony in Our Nation and Peace in the World." On **Wednesday, October 22, from 7:00am until 7:00pm**, St. Mary church in Wrentham will be open for Eucharistic Adoration before the Blessed Sacrament. What a gift it is to host such a day! In the midst of so much division in our country and conflict in our world, we are invited to place everything before Jesus, who is our Prince of Peace. In silence before the Eucharist, we remember that harmony and reconciliation are possible — not because of our own strength, but because Christ himself breaks down walls of hostility and makes us one — *if* we invite him to.

Throughout the day, the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed on the altar, with Benediction closing the day at 7:00pm. Mass will take place as usual, and then Adoration will resume until the evening. To make this possible, the Church asks that *at least* two adorers be present in the church for each hour of prayer when the Eucharist is exposed. **I am inviting parishioners from both of our collaborative parishes** — **St. Martha and St. Mary** — **to commit to spending an hour before the Lord on this special day.** To facilitate the scheduling of 2-3 people each hour to be present, we are providing online signup through our website link to Signup Genius, or you can sign-up in person when you come to weekend Masses. Others are welcome to come beyond those scheduled — in fact, we chose to use St. Mary church so that children attending Faith Formation classes that day can spend some time in prayer and adoration — but we need commitment

from a few each hour to be able to host this important prayer event.

This is a moment of grace for our collaborative parishes and those who will join us that day. Let us take our place before the Lord, asking him to heal our divisions, strengthen our hope, and send us forth as instruments of his peace. Please sign up for an hour if you are able, and together, let us lift our nation and our world into the heart of Christ.
