From the supernatural intervention by which St. Philomena survived two execution attempts, to the miracles that have been wrought through her intercession; this little saint has earned the nickname "wonder worker". Though St. Philomena lived approximately 1700 years ago and was only discovered in the catacombs of Rome in the early 1800's, her faithful witness as a young virgin who was martyred for her purity and fidelity to Christ speaks powerfully to our culture, and especially to young people. Commonly referred to as a "wonder worker", she has the distinction of being the only saint canonized solely on the basis of the profound miracles attributed to her intercession.
