**Pray for Overland Park Parish Vandalized
for Value Them Both Support**

An escalating pattern of theft, vandalism and intimidation targeting members of the Catholic Church and other supporters of the VTB Amendment reached a new level recently when the Church of the Ascension in Overland Park fell victim to vandalism. Parish building, including a statue of the Blessed Mother, were extensively defaced with red spray paint. Authorities were notified and asked that every action be taken to identify and hold the perpetrator accountable. "This attack and others targeting Catholic churches across the country are un-American. The intention is clearly meant to intimidate and threaten the Church's pro-life beliefs and position of support for the VTB Amendment. We will not be deterred. The Catholic Church remains firm in its support of mothers and preborn babies and our members are more dedicated to our mission than ever before." --Archbishop Joseph Naumann. We ask for prayers for the Church of the Ascension's parish community, for civility leading up to the August 2 vote, and for those committing these acts of vandalism.

Second World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly

The World Day for Grandparents and Elderly is July 24. The theme for this year's celebration is "In Old Age They Will Still Bear Fruit" (Ps. 92:15). The theme is meant to emphasize how grandparents are a gift both to society and the Church. This year, Pope Francis is also extending the opportunity for a plenary indulgence "to the faithful who devote adequate time to visit, in presence or virtually through the media, their elderly brothers and sisters in need or in difficulty" on July 24. "Visiting the elderly who live alone is a work of mercy in our time". *Pope Francis*

Value Them Both - Clarifying Misinformation

There has been much misinformation coming from the ads of the opposition of the Value Them Both Amendment. Unfortunately, this is causing confusion around some very sensitive and important topics. The opposition is claiming that if Value Them Both passes, women will not be able to receive medical treatment for miscarriages or other life-threatening situations such as ectopic pregnancies or other pregnancy complications. This is simply not true. Medical treatments for ectopic pregnancies, miscarriages and other pregnancy complications are not the same as an abortion. Kansas has a very clear legal definition of abortion (K.S.A. 65-6701(a)).

The treatment for an ectopic pregnancy is NOT an abortion.

The treatment for miscarriage is NOT an abortion.

The treatment for septic uterus is NOT an abortion.

In addition, reputable physicians who treat high-risk or traumatic pregnancies will say an abortion is not medically necessary to treat or save the life of the mother. To learn more, visit archkck.org/valuethemboth under "Resources – FAQs".

Value Them Both Coalition Statement

The recent Decision on *Dobbs v. Jackson* emphasizes the importance of our democracy, restoring the power to the states to decide how and if they are going to place limits on the abortion industry. The U.S.

Supreme Court restored the people's ability to come to individual consensus on abortion limits – *but not in Kansas*. As it stands today, unelected judges in Kansas are the ones who will decide the fate of abortion limits. The Value Them Both Amendment is a reasonable approach and will ensure Kansas does not remain a permanent destination for the most extreme and painful abortion procedures. At this historically important time, the question before Kansans on August 2 is clear: an unregulated abortion industry with no limits at all *OR* the reasonable limits protected by the Value Them Both Amendment. Kansas voters will vote on Value Them Both on August 2. This opportunity on August 2 will allow Kansas voters to have a voice to ensure the state does not become a permanent destination for extreme abortion procedures. Without Value Them Both, Kansas abortion law will become as extreme as New York and California.
