Church of Our Lady of Good Counsel - St. Thomas More January 8th, 2017 Epiphany of the Lord

The season of Christmas is a celebration of both Jesus' birth and his epiphany to the world. Today, on Epiphany Sunday, we acknowledge God's manifestation of his Son to the world.

In today's reading, we hear about the mystery "made known to me [Paul] by revelation...that the Gentiles are coheirs, members of the same body, and copartners in the promise in Christ Jesus." Paul and the next generation of Pauline Christians clearly saw that God's plan for the salvation of all people "has now been revealed" in Jesus Christ. While today we celebrate the epiphany of Christ to the world, the early Gentile followers of Jesus were met with great resistance from Jews who historically saw themselves as defined culturally and religiously as "separate" from the other nations, as God's "chosen" people. It remains a temptation for many Christians today to see Jesus as the savior of fellow believers alone and not of the entire world.

Matthew's story of the visit of the Magi to Mary and Joseph remains one of the New Testament's central texts revealing God's epiphany of Christ. In numerous ways, this story previews the drama of Jesus' life once he begins his public ministry. Like Herod and the religious leadership of Jerusalem who were "greatly troubled" at news of the birth of the Messiah, so, too, in Jesus' adult life the religious leaders of his day would be greatly troubled by Jesus, and sought a means to destroy him. But to others, like the Wise Men, representing the other nations of the world, the news of the birth of the Christ would bring great joy. And so, too, the words and deeds of Jesus brought joy to many who experienced him in his public ministry. Many rightly paid "homage" to him like the Magi. The readings for the Epiphany of the Lord teach us not only that God is faithful to his covenantal promises, but also call us to share the epiphany of Christ to all nations of the world.
