Church of Our Lady of Good Counsel - St. Thomas More February 02, 2020 The Presentation of the Lord

The feast of the Presentation of the Lord commemorates Mary and Joseph dedicating the infant Jesus to the Lord in the Temple in Jerusalem. The first reading is taken from the Book of Malachi. *Malachi* is a Hebrew phrase simply meaning, "my messenger." The criticisms contained in this short prophetic book are especially pointed given this oracle is pronounced only a generation after Israel's return from captivity in Babylon.

How Jesus' suffering and death fit into God's plan for salvation was a topic of deep discussion and discernment among the earliest followers of Christ. The author of the Letter to the Hebrews presents Jesus' suffering as essential to his role as the "merciful and faithful high priest."

In the Gospel reading, Luke presents Mary and Joseph as observant Jews of the Mosaic Law. Only after their "purification" do Mary and Joseph offer animal sacrifice in Jerusalem's Temple as a means of consecrating their first son to God. The longer version of this Gospel reading concludes with a summary statement about Jesus as a boy growing up in the village of Nazareth. For Luke, it was important to emphasize that Mary and Joseph educated and formed Jesus in their Jewish traditions and customs.
