# Church of Our Lady of Good Counsel - St. Thomas More October 16, 2022 **Twenty-Ninth Sunday in Ordinary Time**

The readings for the Twenty-ninth Sunday in Ordinary Time encourage tenacity and diligence in our spiritual affairs. The first reading is taken from the Book of Exodus and presents one of the early Israelite battles and victories they experienced during their forty-year journey through the desert to the Promised Land, an experience that taught Moses and the Israelites about the fidelity of God and the fragility of humanity.

The second reading from 2 Timothy presents one of the most commonly quoted references in the New Testament to divine inspiration: "All scripture is inspired by God and is useful in teaching, for refutation, for correction, and for training in righteousness, so that one who belongs to God may be competent, equipped for every good work"

The Gospel reading is the parable of the Persistent Widow. Included in this parable is the Lucan theme of the great reversal in fortune for the weak and marginalized in Jesus' good news about the kingdom of God. The parable ends with Jesus challenging his disciples: "But when the Son of Man comes, will he find faith on earth?" Adapted from Liturgical Publications Inc, Connect!
