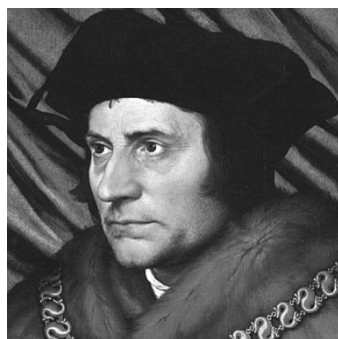

Third Sunday of Easter

The readings for the Third Sunday of Easter continue to offer us insights into how the early Christians formulated their beliefs about Jesus and themselves in light of his life, death, and resurrection. In the first reading, Luke provides us with an example of the early church's technique for instructing outsiders in the faith. In this reading, Peter begins with the historical Jesus, and then offers Scripture as a proof that the resurrection of Christ was foretold to Israel. Next, Peter teaches that the death and resurrection of Jesus fulfill God's covenant established with King David and a glimpse of the early church's catechesis.

The second reading from First Peter is a moral exhortation: "conduct yourself with reverence during the time of your sojourning." Peter's expectation for good conduct, in light of Christ's death and resurrection, called believers to a new level of reverence for each other and a "faith and hope" in God who will likewise raise them from the dead.

The Gospel reading for today is the appearance of the resurrected Christ to the two disciples on the road to Emmaus. In this Resurrection narrative two disciples encounter the resurrected Christ on the road to Emmaus and it concludes by reporting that the two disciples returned immediately to Jerusalem, informing "the eleven" of the events that transpired. From their experience of the resurrected Christ in the breaking of the bread, the disciples went out into the world and proclaimed the good news: "The Lord has truly been raised!"
