## *Summer Sizzle Update*

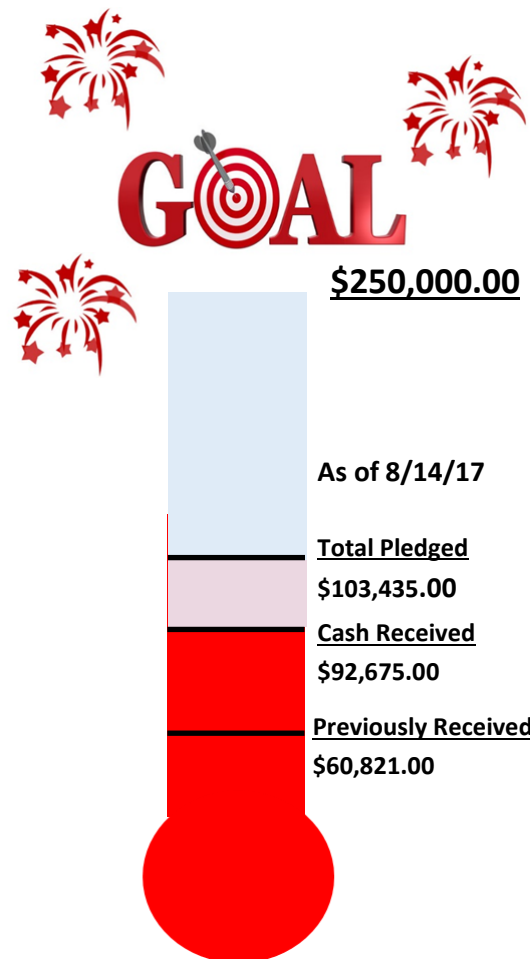
