RELIGIOUS EDUCATION AND YOUTH MINISTRY

We would like to welcome families back to our Religious Ed. Program. Next Sunday, September 13th is the deadline to register for RE classes and youth groups which begin on **September 20th and 23rd**. This year, due to safety measures, no one can be admitted to class unless they have registered. Every person entering the hall must be signed in each week with a current phone number for contact tracing to meet the safety requirements of the Archdiocese of Portland.

Also, facemasks are to be worn by teachers, parents, and students. Social distancing is required just like in the church. Classrooms and the main hall have been set up to meet that need. We are asking parents to bring their children to the hall side door by the parking lot for class. Teachers will escort children within the building and return them to parents who will pick them up outside. Parents who would like to stay with their child in class will need to sign in at the door and wear a facemask. There will not be any gathering in the hall for adults during class. Following these new procedures should lower the chances for exposure to the Coronavirus. We appreciate your cooperation in keeping our parish children safe.

This week another \$1 Billion USDA grant has made it possible for Oregon families to continue to receive FREE produce, dairy or combo boxes distributed at selected Archdiocese of Portland Catholic Churches. St Cyril joined this endeavor on July 1st and since the inception has distributed **1770** boxes totaling more than **46,020 lbs** of food or **\$53,380!!** As our Wilsonville community has become aware of the program, we have seen a weekly increase in the number of people receiving these amazing food boxes.

The food boxes have helped so many people, not only the hungry, but also have provided a use for produce and dairy that was being discarded. In addition, all employees at Pacific Coast Fruit who had been placed on furlough have been reinstated and are working to package and distribute the food boxes throughout Oregon. This has been an amazing program for all! This program is for EVERYONE. As you have read, these food boxes help so many people in so many different ways.

Please feel free to drive through and pick up boxes for yourself, family and neighbors on Wednesdays from 9:30 am until the boxes are gone. The distribution of 240 boxes usually only takes about an hour, so arrive early and follow the flaggers! We hope to see you there!

REFLECTION: TWENTY-THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

‘If another member of the church sins against you, go and point out the fault when the two of you are alone. If the member listens to you, you have regained that one. But if you are not listened to, take one or two others along with you, so that every word may be confirmed by the evidence of two or three witnesses. If the member refuses to listen to them, tell it to the church; and if the offender refuses to listen even to the church, let such a one be to you as a Gentile and a tax-collector. Truly I tell you, whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven. Again, truly I tell you, if two of you agree on earth about anything you ask, it will be done for you by my Father in heaven. For where two or three are gathered in my name, I am there among them.’

Some thoughts on today's scripture

- To what extent do we feel responsible for the wrongdoings of our fellow-Christians? To what extent do we realize that our behavior both as individuals and groups reflects on the overall witness that the Church is called to give.
- “Where two or three are gathered in my name, I am there among them”. Let us pray today for a greater awareness and understanding of these words of Jesus. Let us pray for eyes to see and ears to hear Jesus among us.
