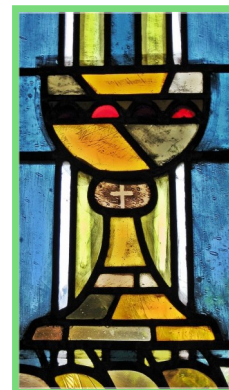

at the east door of the church. Please return by May 29th.



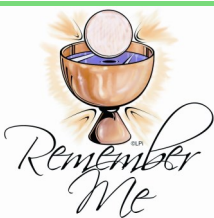
