

There is a false form of honesty that suggests that nothing should remain hidden and that everything should be said, expressed, and communicated. Just as words lose their power when they are not born out of silence, so openness loses its meaning when there is no ability to be closed.

St. Cyril's St. Vincent de Paul volunteers thank the parishioners for their contributions in the past year to provide food and financial assistance to those in need in Wilsonville. In our fiscal year, we helped 69 families, which included 159 people, with food, rent and utilities. The value of this help was \$22,120, plus \$6,120 in gift cards at Christmas to 26 families, which included 97 people. This assistance could not happened without your steady contributions.
