

SEPTEMBER 17, 2023 – 24TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME "THE LORD IS KIND AND MERCIFUL. SLOW TO ANGER. AND RICH IN COMPASSION." - PSALM 103

Today, in the Gospel of Saint Matthew, Peter asks Jesus about how often one is expected to forgive the sins of another. At times, we can share this question of forgiveness asked by Peter. Sometimes it is very challenging to extend forgiveness. Yet, the reply that Jesus offers is a challenge to the idea of limiting our acts of pardon and forgiveness. As Jesus makes clear in his parable, we who have been treated with such pardon, mercy, and forgiveness by God must share this grace with those who sin against us. Reconciliation only occurs when the gift of forgiveness is shared. As difficult as this might be, the grace of forgiveness and pardon is transformational. Jesus provides us an example and invites us to share in his gifts of pardon, reconciliation and peace. May we always be eager to pass along the divine gifts of pardon and peace.
