

SEPTEMBER 24, 2023 – 25TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME "THE LORD IS NEAR TO ALL WHO CALL UPON HIM." – PSALM 145

Today, in the Gospel of Saint Matthew, Jesus shares a parable of an owner of a vineyard who hires workers throughout the day, and ultimately pays all, even those who worked only a short time. the same daily wage. Those who worked for the entire day become frustrated and upset because they see themselves as being considered equal to the last workers hired. But, the landowner responds that he has the right to be generous with his own money. This point of the landowner highlights both the point and the context of this parable of Jesus. Jesus initially shares the parable because the Pharisees were upset that public sinners were coming to Jesus and receiving the gifts of forgiveness and mercy. These Pharisees had lived their entire lives committed to following all the laws and statutes of the Law of Moses. Yet, those who had been gravely sinning and only "recently" come seeking pardon were hearing Jesus also offering them forgiveness and the merciful love of God. Like the generous landowner, God desires all, both saints and sinners, experience the blessings of infinite forgiveness and Divine Mercy. The gifts of forgiveness and mercy are lavabundantly poured out by our loving God ishlv and upon the whole May God – Father, Son, Holy Spirit – abundantly bless you and your families in this coming week!
