OCTOBER 8, 2023 – 27TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME **“THE VINEYARD OF THE LORD IS THE HOUSE OF ISRAEL.” – PSALM 80**

Today, in the Gospel of Saint Matthew, Jesus shares the parable of the ungrateful tenants. The tenants refused to recognize their relationship and dependence upon the owner of the vineyard. Ultimately, this refusal to honor the owner of the vineyard led to the tenants killing the beloved son. Jesus is speaking of his own rejection and death in the images of this parable. Jesus truly is the stone rejected by the builders that becomes the most valuable stone in the sight of God.

Our sins are moments of rejection of Jesus. In turning from the Lord and his gift of life, we reject Jesus as the cornerstone of our spiritual home. Jesus gently calls us back to his path of life and truth. It is truly a gift of wonder to recognize our dependence and need for Jesus as our savior. May the words and example of Jesus always guide us along the paths of the journey of life.

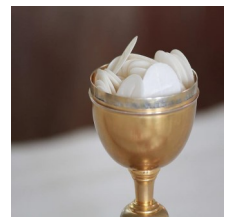
THE NATIONAL EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL **THE REAL PRESENCE OF JESUS**
